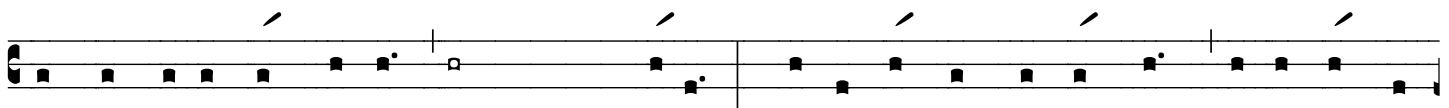
[Jesus said to his disciples,] “If you love me, you will keep my com-mand-ments. ¹⁶ And I will ask the

truth, whom the world cannot receive, because it neither sees him nor knows him. You know him,



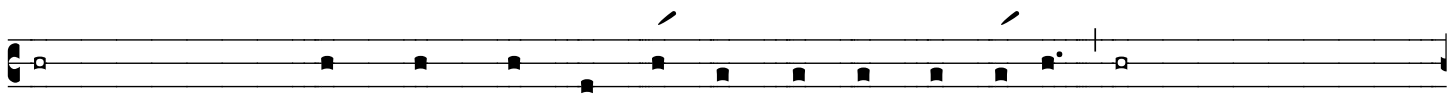
be-cause he a-bides with you, and he will be in you. ¹⁸ “I will not leave you or-phaned; I am com-ing



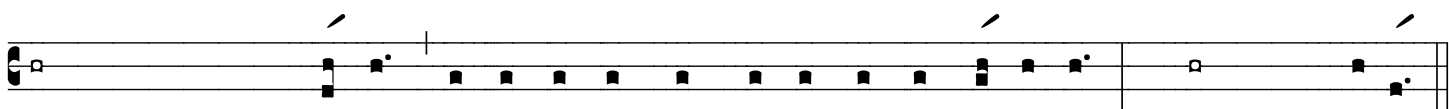
to you. ¹⁹ In a little while the world will no lon-ger see me, but you will see me; because I live, you al-
