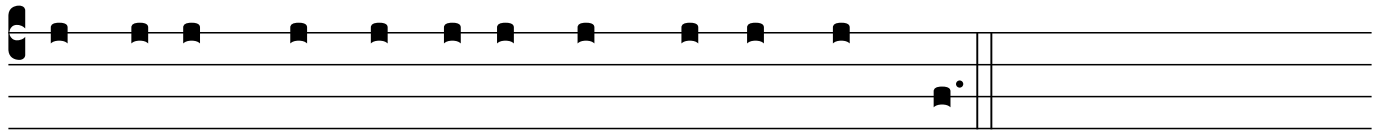
Mount Zi- on and o-ver its plac-es of assem-bly a cloud by day and smoke
