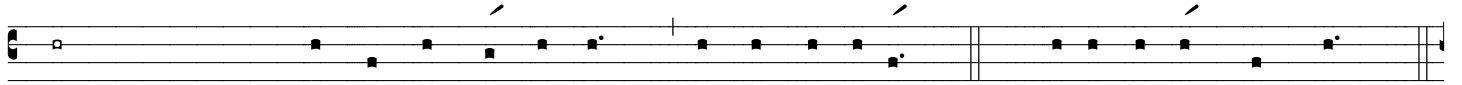

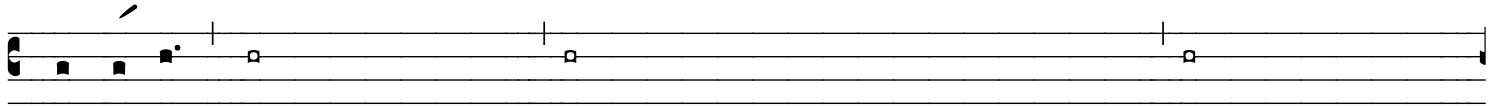

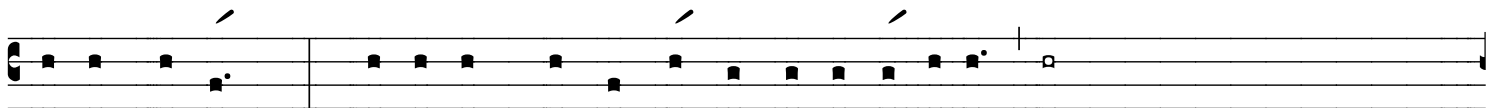
∿ The Holy Gospel of our Lord Je-sus Christ ac-cord-ing to Mark. ✠ *Glo-ry to you, Lord Christ.*



Now after John was ar-rest-ed, Je-sus came to Gal- i- lee, proclaiming the good news of God, ¹⁵



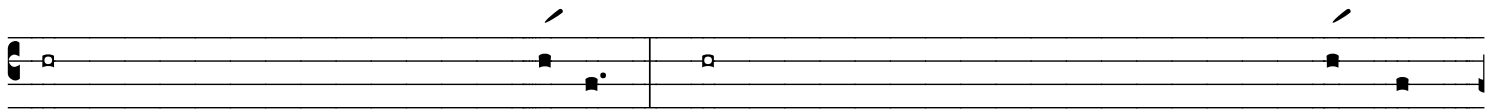
and say-ing, “The time is fulfilled, and the kingdom of God has come near; repent, and believe



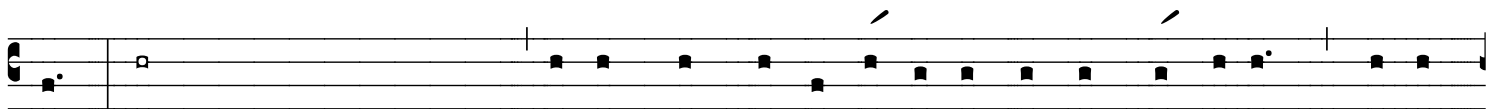
in the good news.” ¹⁶ As Je-sus passed a-long the Sea of Gal-i- lee, he saw Simon and his brother



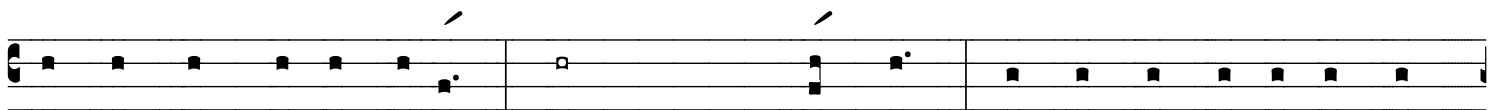
Andrew casting a net into the sea--for they were fish-er-men. ¹⁷ And Je-sus said to them, “Fol-low
