## Epiphany 5 (Year B, RCL) — Mark 1:29-39 (NRSV) V. The Holy Gospel of our Lord Je-sus Christ ac-cord-ing to Mark. R. Glo-ry to you, Lord Christ. Jesus left the synagogue at Capernaum and entered the house of Si-mon and An-drew, with James and John. 30 Now Simon's mother-in-law was in bed with a fe-ver, and they told him about her at once. 31 He came and took her by the hand and lifted her up.
