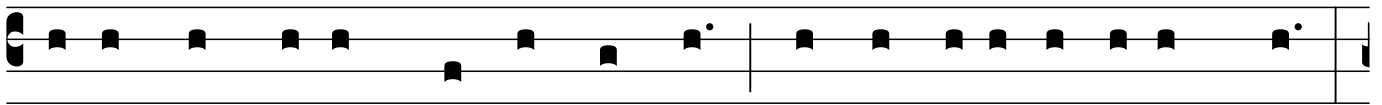
**A**c-cording to the grace of God giv-en to me, like a wise master builder



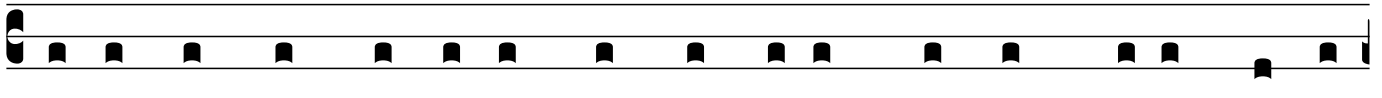
I laid a foundation, and someone else is build-ing on it. Let each builder



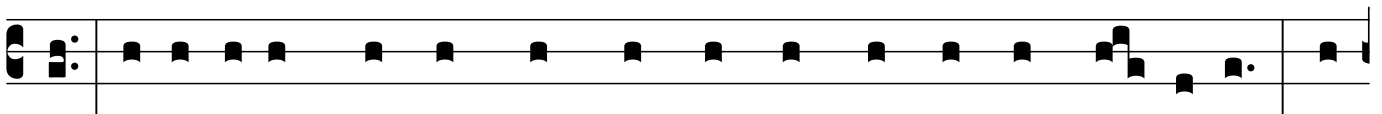
choose with care how to build on it. For no one can lay an-y foundation



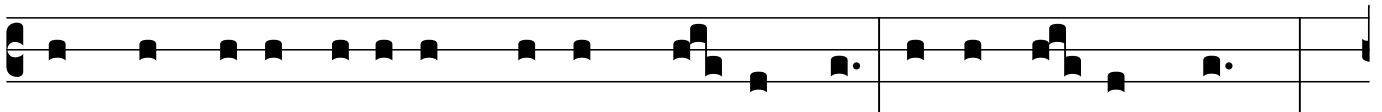
other than the one that has been laid; that foundation is Je-sus Christ.



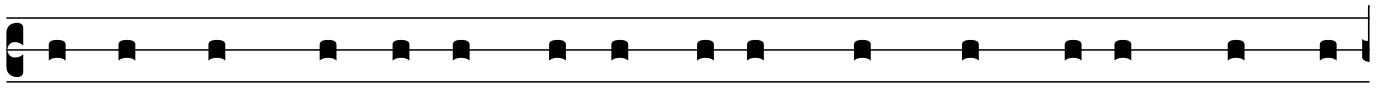
Do you not know that you are God's temple and that God's Spir-it dwells in



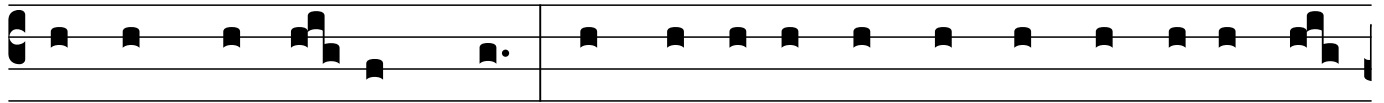
you? If an-y-one destroys God's temple, God will destroy that person. For



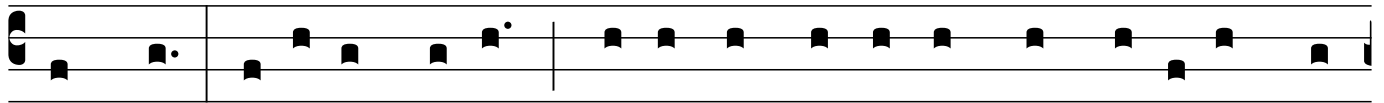
God's temple is ho-ly, and you are that temple. Do not de- ceive yourselves.



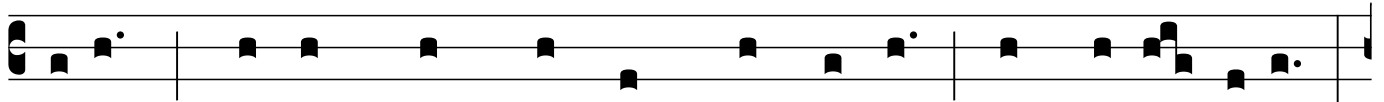
If you think that you are wise in this age, you should be-come fools so



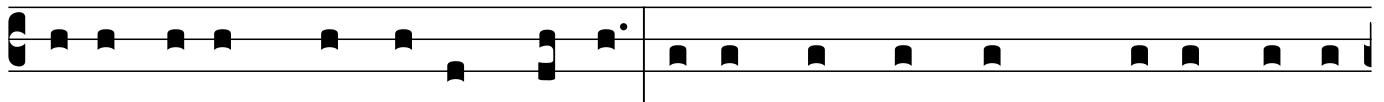
that you may be- come wise. For the wisdom of this world is fool-ishness



with God. For it is writ-ten, “He catches the wise in their craft-i-ness,” and



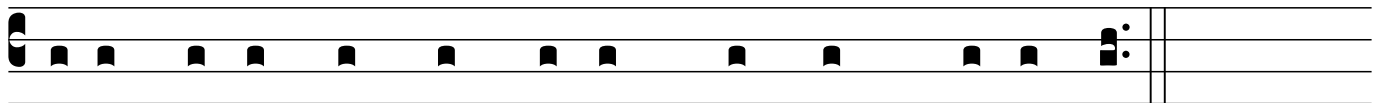
again, “The Lord knows the thoughts of the wise, that they are fu-tile.”
