
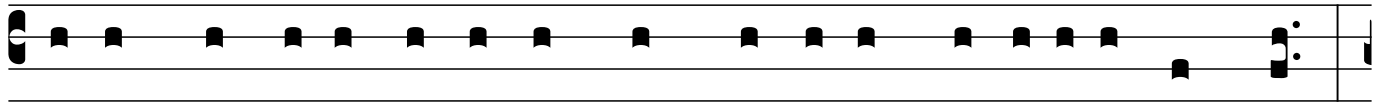


2 Peter 1:16-21

confirmed. You will do well to be attentive to this as to a lamp shin-ing in



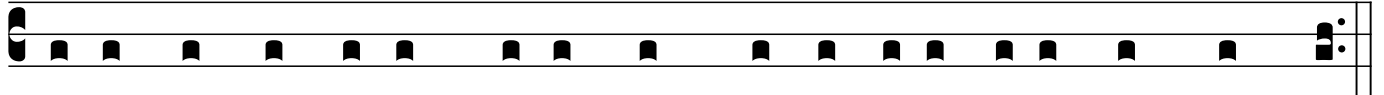
a dark place, until the day dawns and the morning star ris-es in your hearts.
