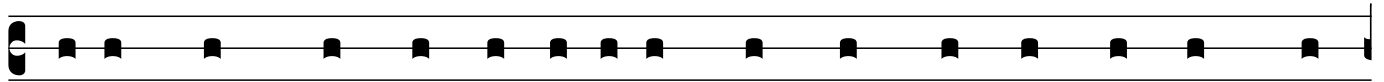

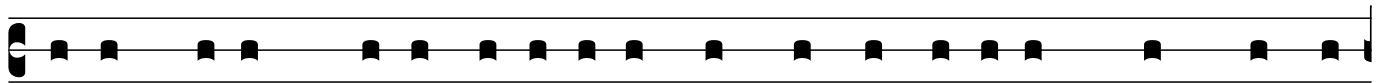

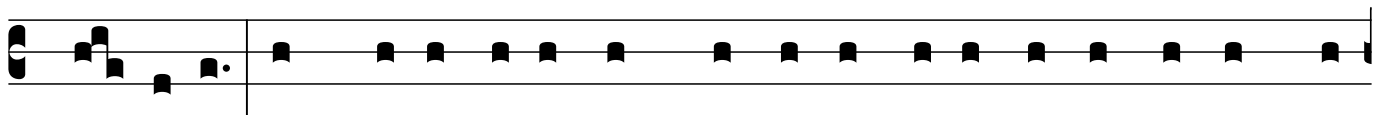
**B**ut as for you, continue in what you have learned and firmly believed,



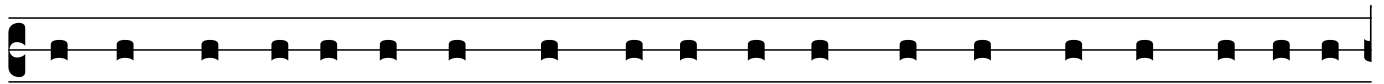
knowing from whom you learned it and how from childhood you have known



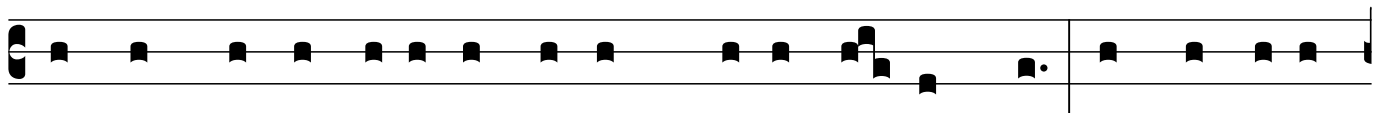
sacred writings that are able to instruct you for salvation through faith in



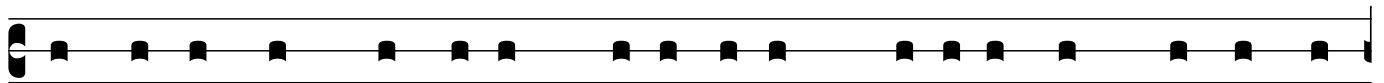
Christ Jesus. All scripture is inspired by God and is useful for teaching, for



reproof, for correction, and for training in righteousness, so that the person



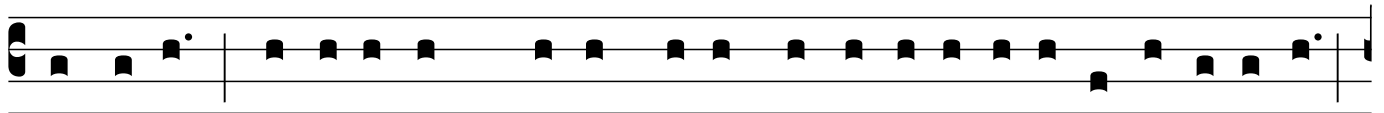
of God may be proficient, equipped for every good work. In the presence



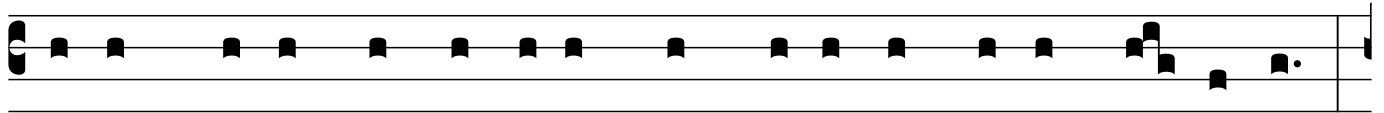
of God and of Christ Jesus, who is to judge the living and the dead, and



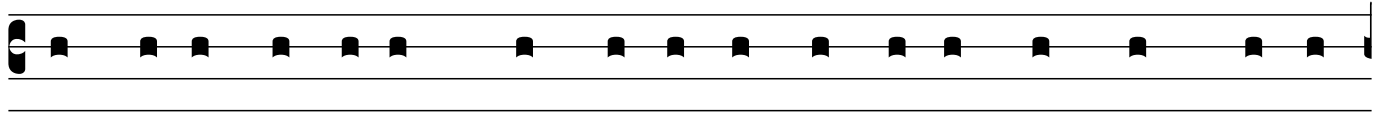
in view of his appearing and his kingdom, I solemnly urge you: proclaim



the message; be persis-tent whether the time is fa-vor-able or unfa-vor-able;



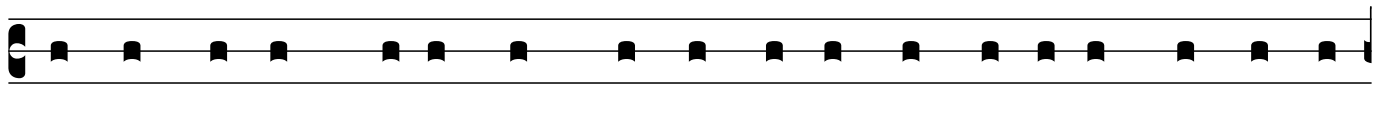
convince, re-buke, and encourage with the utmost pa-tience in teaching.



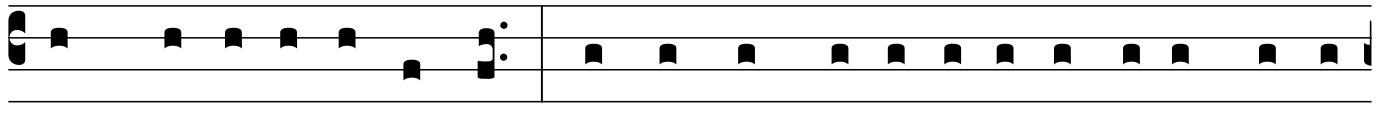
For the time is coming when people will not put up with sound teaching,



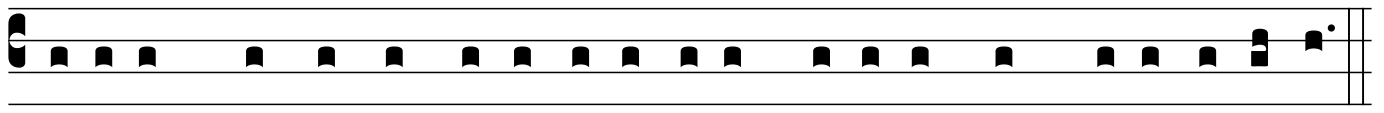
but, hav-ing their ears tickled, they will accumu-late for themselves teachers
