


Acts 4:1-12

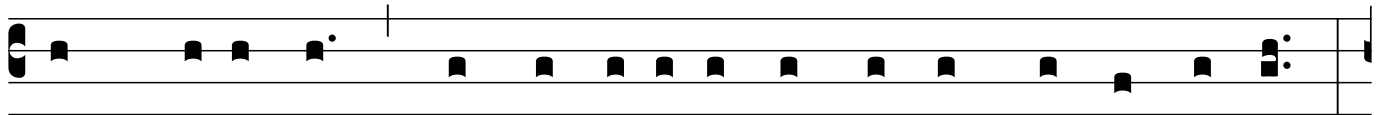
Friday in Easter Week



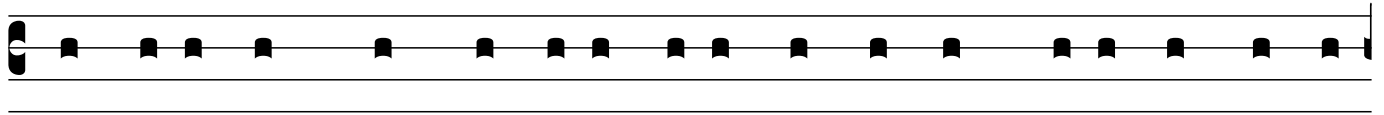
While Pe-ter and John were speaking to the people, the priests, the cap-

the high priest, Cai-aphas, John, and Al-ex-ander, and all who were of the



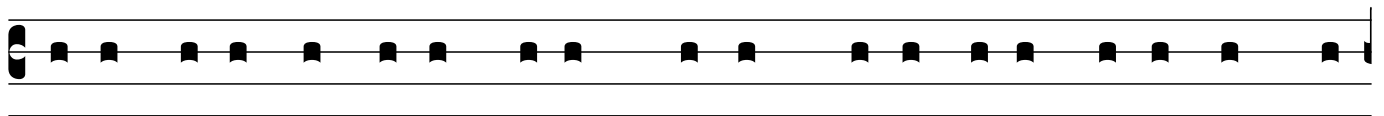
high-priestly fami-ly. When they had made the pris-on-ers stand in their



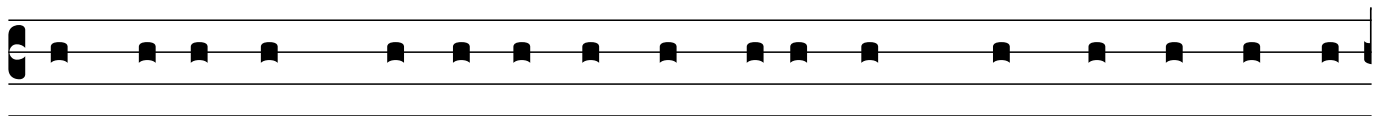
midst, they inquired, “By what power or by what name did you do this?”



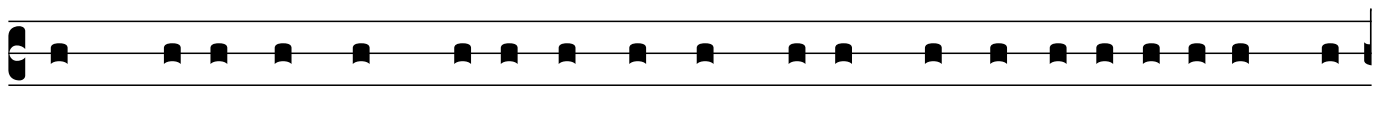
Then Pe-ter, filled with the Ho-ly Spir-it, said to them, “Rul-ers of the peo-



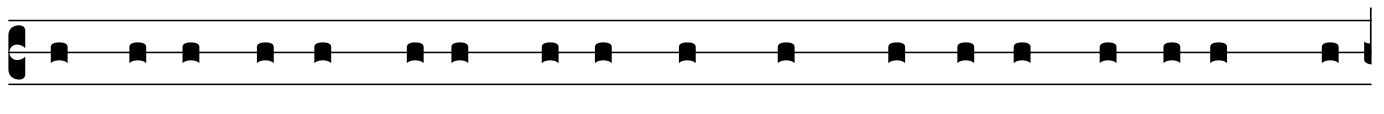
ple and elders, if we are be-ing questioned today because of a good deed



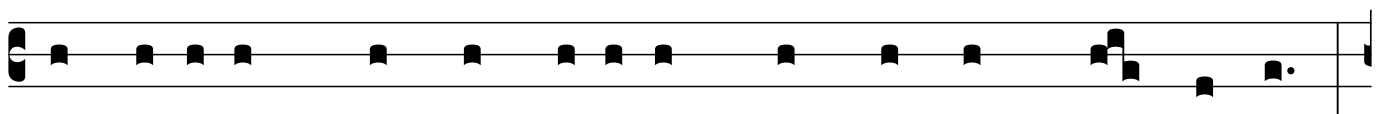
done to someone who was sick and are be-ing asked how this man has been



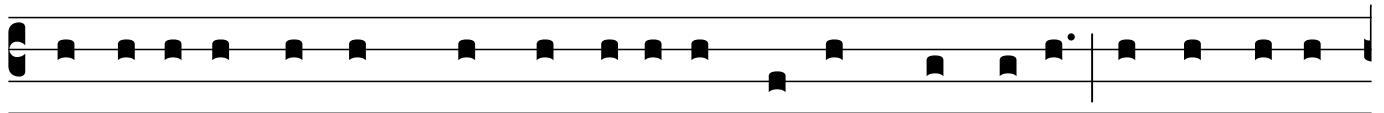
healed, let it be known to all of you, and to all the people of Isra-el, that



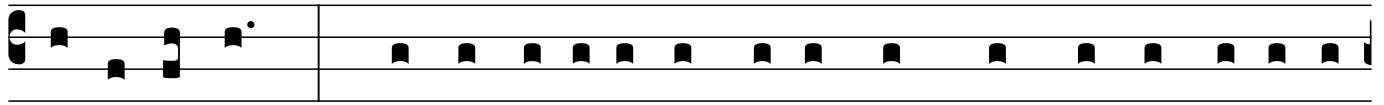
this man is standing be-fore you in good health by the name of Je-sus Christ



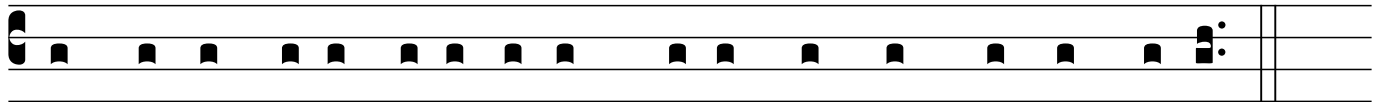
of Naz-a-reth, whom you cru-ci-fied, whom God raised from the dead.
