
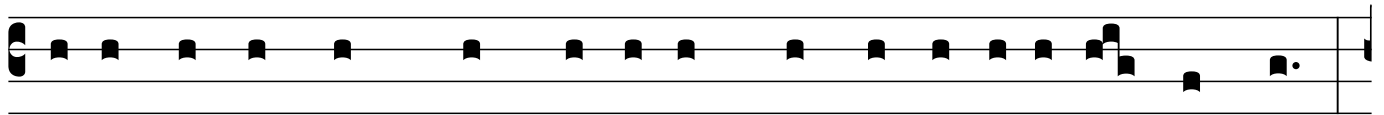


Romans 6:3-11

Great Vigil



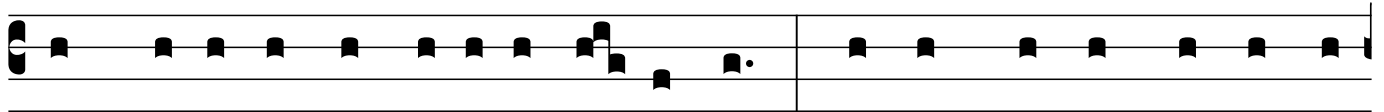
Do you not know that all of us who were baptized into Christ Je-sus

longer be enslaved to sin. For who- ev-er has died is freed from sin.



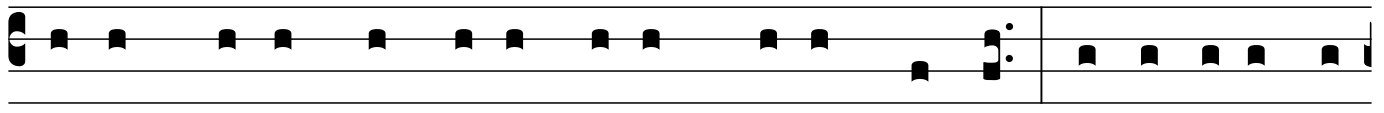
But if we died with Christ, we be-lieve that we will also live with him.



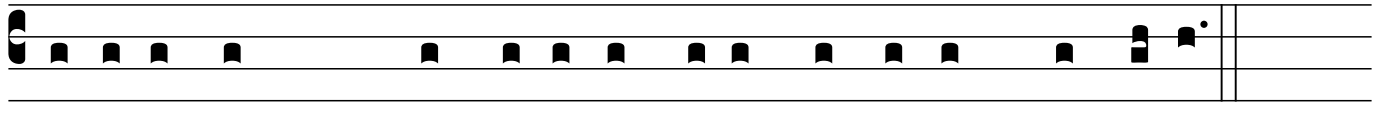
We know that Christ, be- ing raised from the dead, will nev-er die again;
