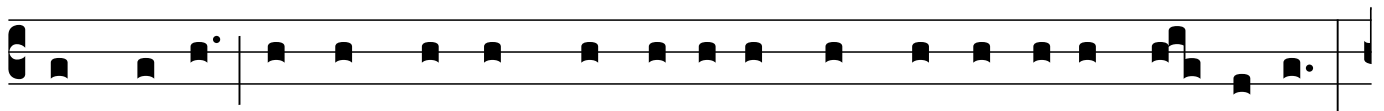
Therefore, as God's cho-sen ones, ho-ly and be-lov-ed, clothe yourselves



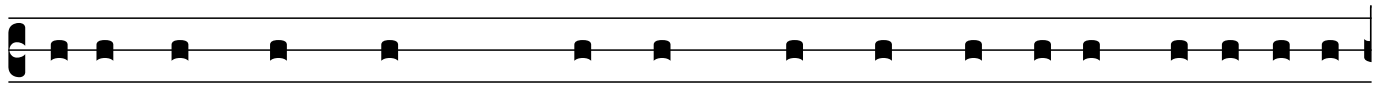
with compassion, kindness, humil- i-ty, meekness, and pa-tience. Bear with



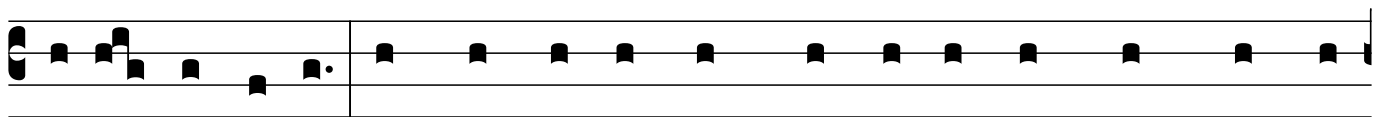
one an-other and, if an-y- one has a complaint against an-other, forgive



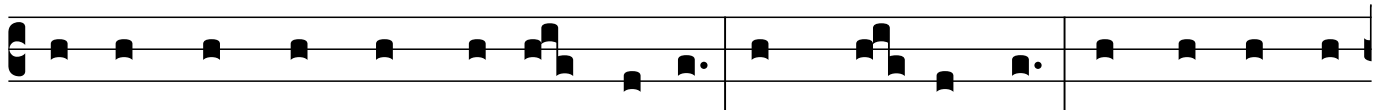
each other; just as the Lord has forgiv-en you, so you also must forgive.



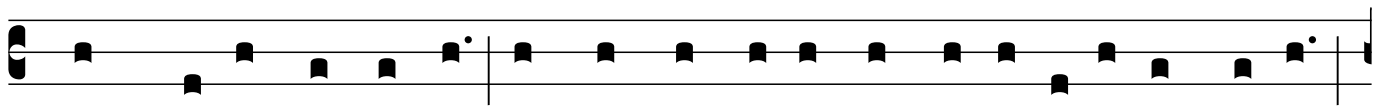
Above all, clothe yourselves with love, which binds everything to-gether in



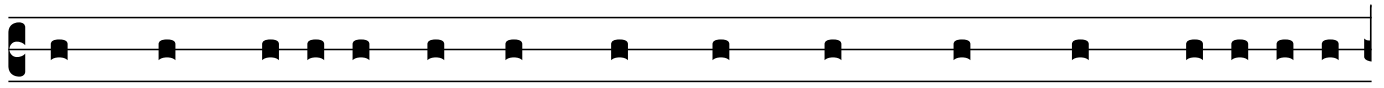
perfect harmo-ny. And let the peace of Christ rule in your hearts, to which



indeed you were called in one bod-y. And be thankful. Let the word of



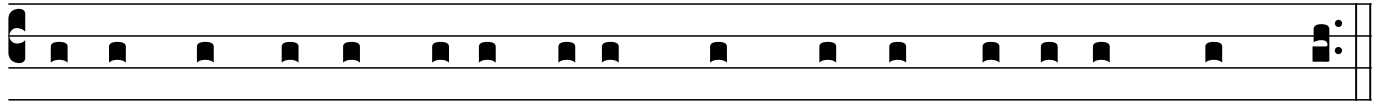
Christ dwell in you richly; teach and admon-ish one an-other in all wisdom;
