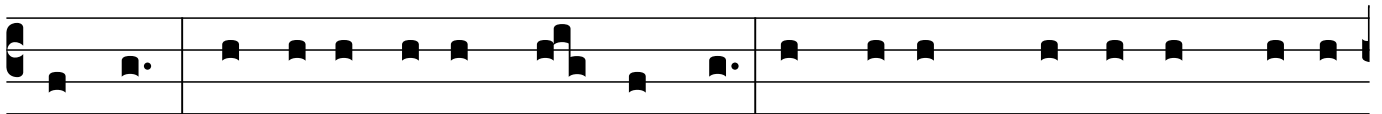
F or I re-ceived from the Lord what I also handed on to you, that



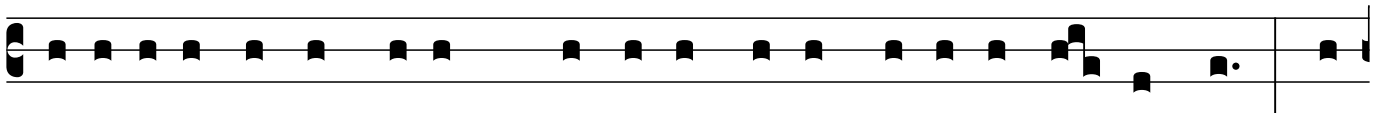
the Lord Je-sus on the night when he was betrayed took a loaf of bread, and



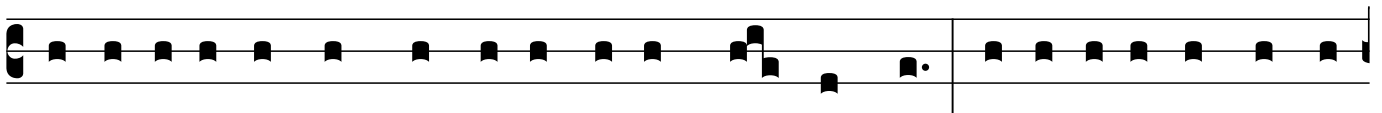
when he had giv-en thanks, he broke it and said, “This is my bod-y that is



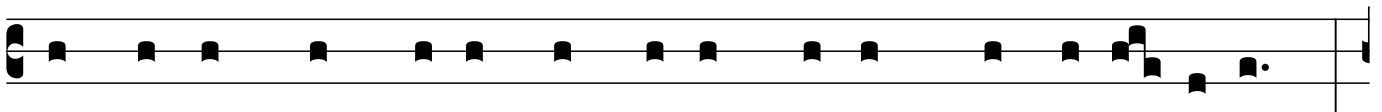
for you. Do this in remembrance of me.” In the same way he took the cup



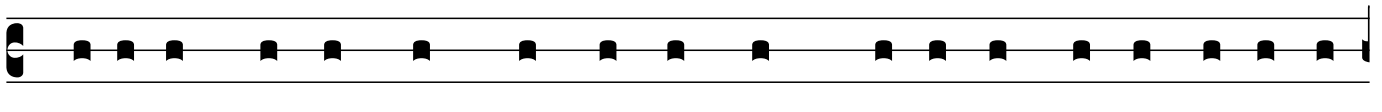
also, after supper, say-ing, “This cup is the new cov-e-nant in my blood. Do



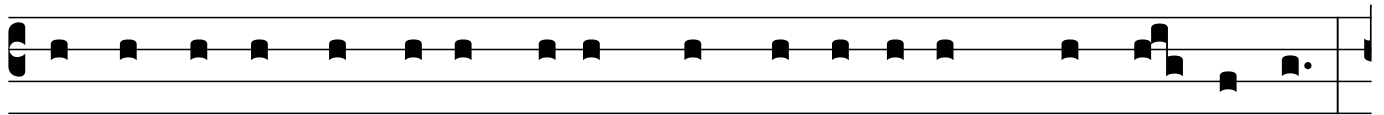
this, as often as you drink it, in remembrance of me.” For as often as you eat



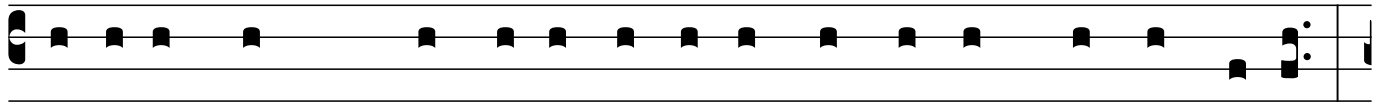
this bread and drink the cup, you proclaim the Lord’s death until he comes.



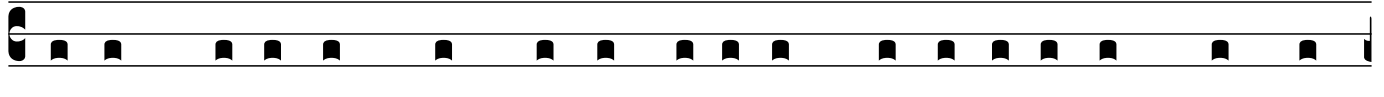
Who- ev-er, therefore, eats the bread or drinks the cup of the Lord in an un-



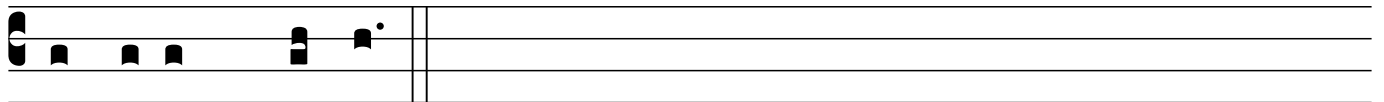
worthy manner will be answer-able for the bod-y and blood of the Lord.
