
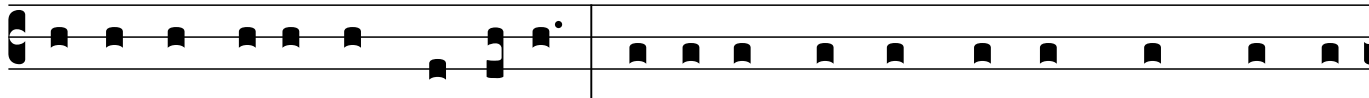

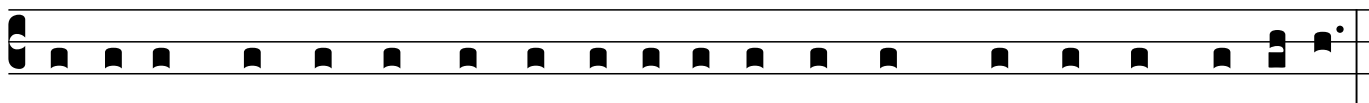
Ordination of a Bishop
