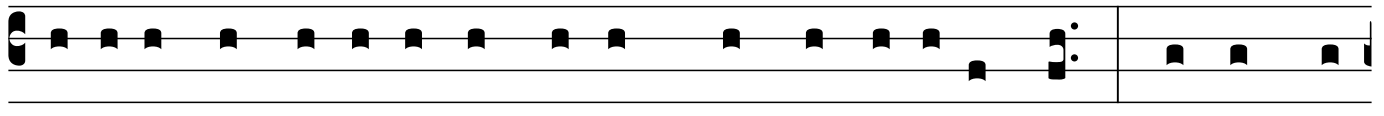
God, with which you were marked with a seal for the day of re-demption.



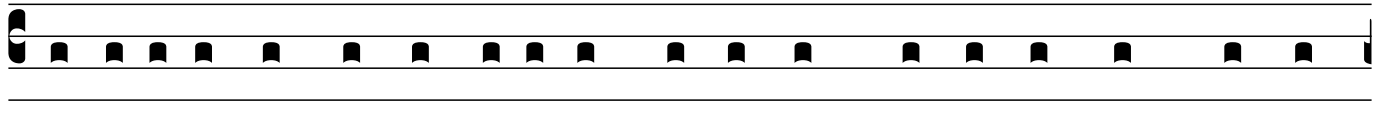
Put away from you all bit-terness and wrath and anger and wrangling and



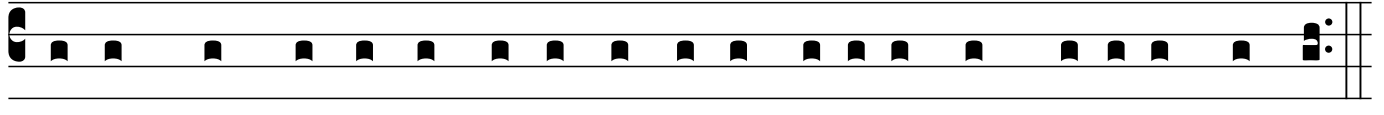
slander, to-gether with all mal-ice. Be kind to one an-other, tenderhearted,
