
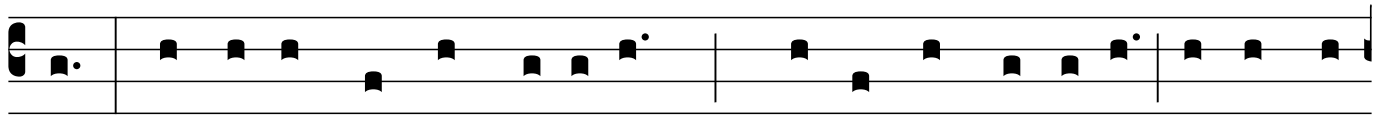


# Hebrews 13:1-8,15-16

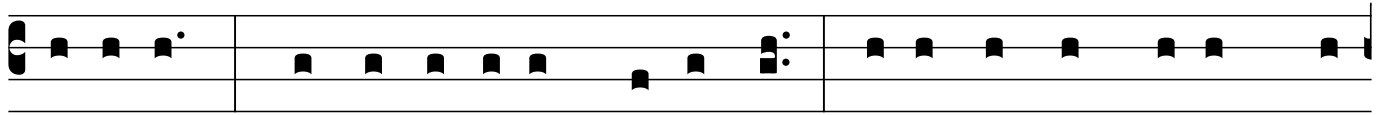

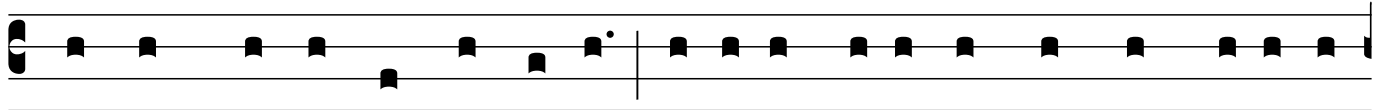
**L** et mu-tu- al affection continue. Do not neglect to show hospi-tal-i-ty

be- ing tortured. Let marriage be held in hon-or by all, and let the marriage

what you have, for he himself has said, "I will nev-er leave you or for- sake



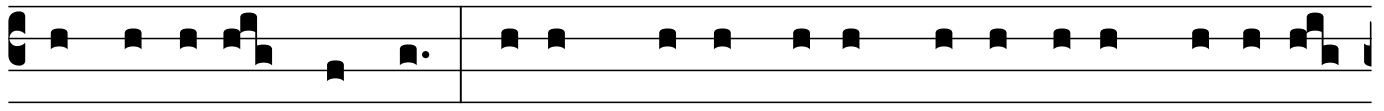
you.” So we can say with confi-dence, “The Lord is my helper; I will not



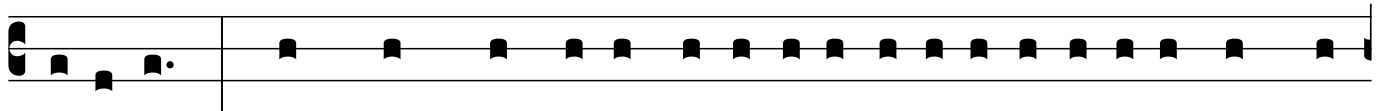
be afraid. What can an-y- one do to me?” Remember your leaders, those



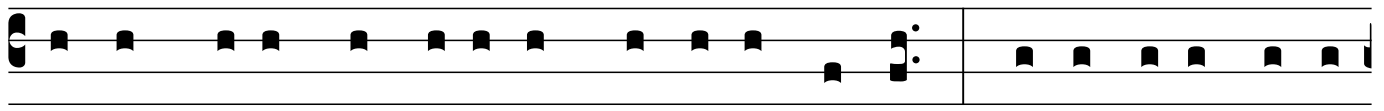
who spoke the word of God to you; consid-er the outcome of their way of life,



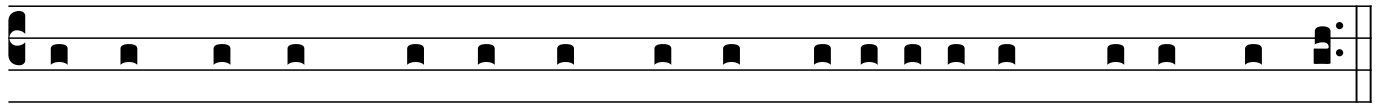
and im-i-tate their faith. Je-sus Christ is the same yesterday and today and
