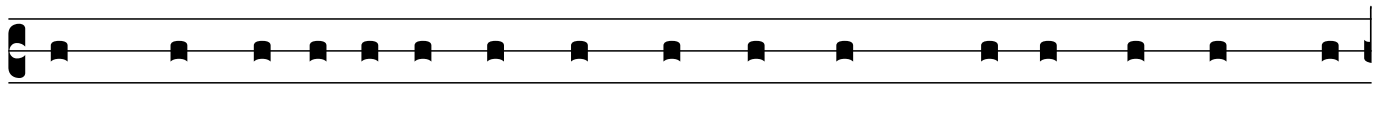
we no one an-thing, except to love one an-other, for the one who



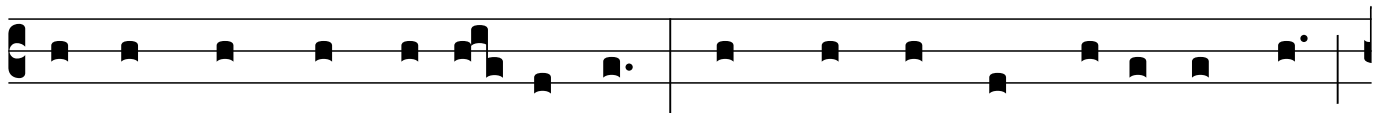
loves an-other has ful-filled the law. The commandments, "You shall not



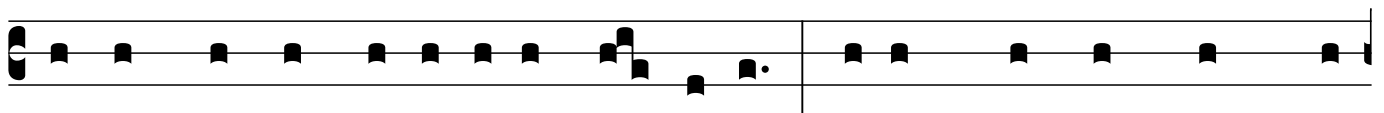
commit adultery; you shall not murder; you shall not steal; you shall not



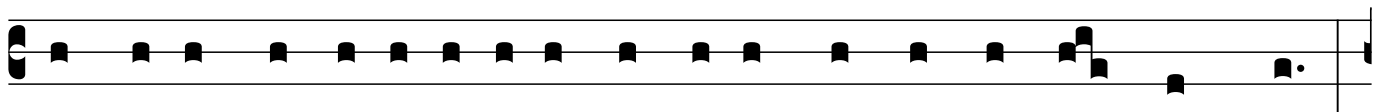
covet," and an-y other commandment, are summed up in this word, "You



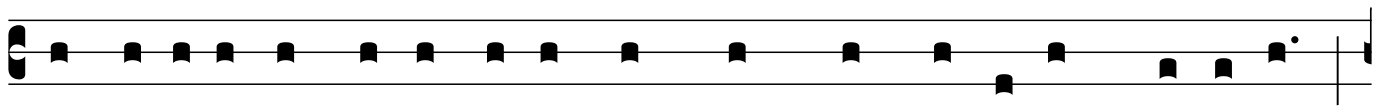
shall love your neighbor as yourself." Love does no wrong to a neighbor;



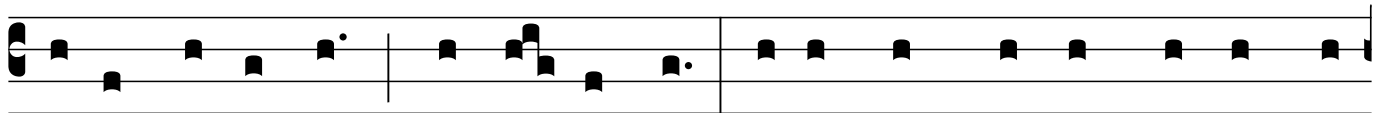
therefore, love is the ful-fill-ing of the law. Be-sides this, you know what



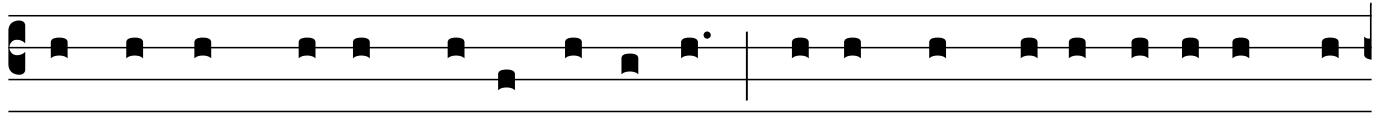
time it is, how it is already the moment for you to wake from sleep.



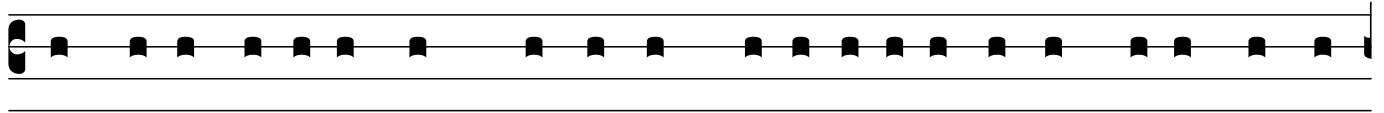
For salvation is near-er to us now than when we be-came be-liev-ers;



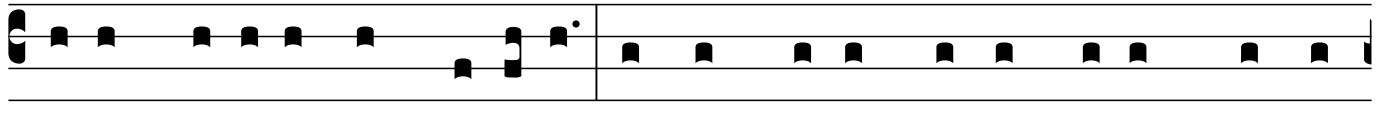
the night is far gone; the day is near. Let us then throw off the works of



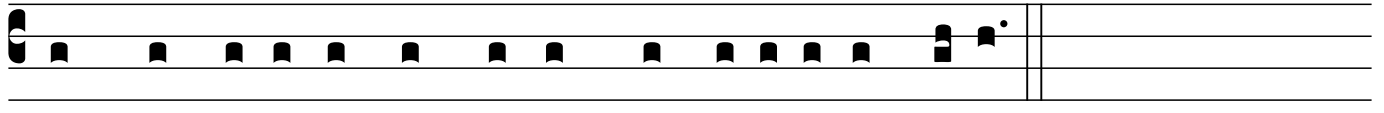
darkness and put on the armor of light; let us walk decently as in the
