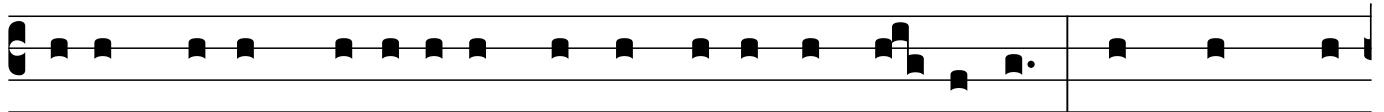

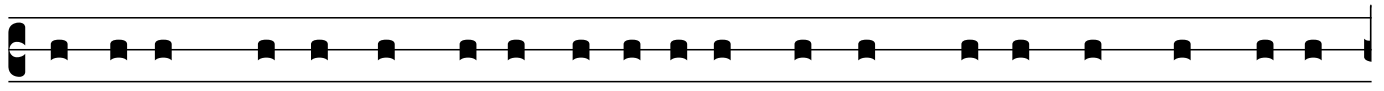

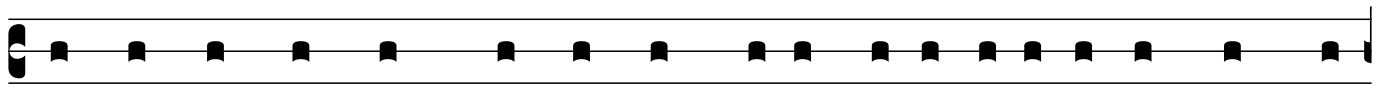
And every priest stands day after day at his service, offer-ing again and



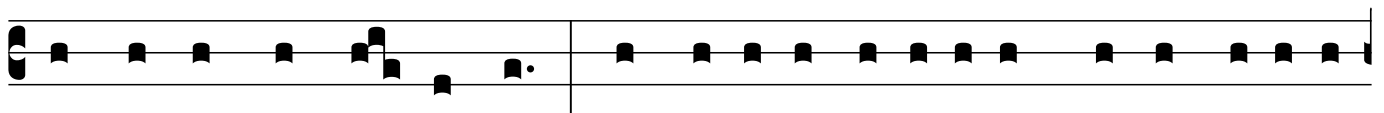
again the same sacri- fic-es that can nev-er take a-way sins. But when Christ



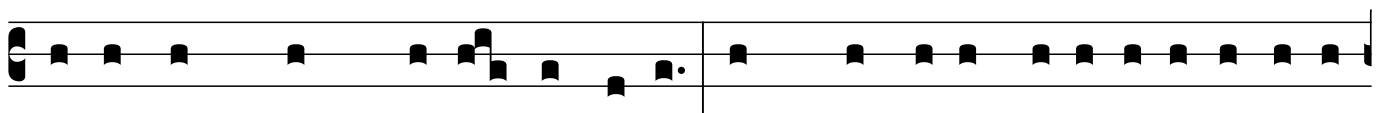
had offered for all time a single sacri- fice for sins,“he sat down at the right



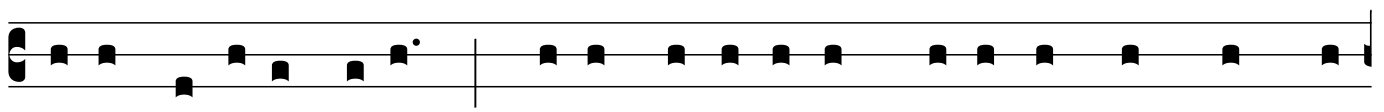
hand of God,” and since then has been wait-ing“until his en-emies would be



made a footstool for his feet.” For by a single offer-ing he has perfected



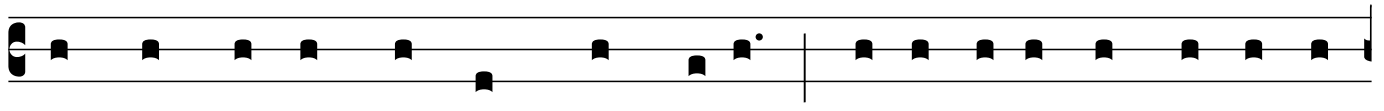
for all time those who are sancti-fied. And the Ho-ly Spir-it also tes-ti-fies



to us, for after say-ing, “This is the cov-e-nant that I will make with them



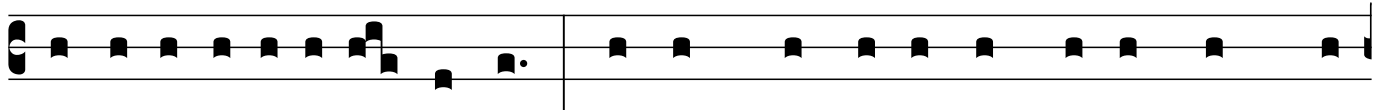
after those days, says the Lord: I will put my laws in their hearts, and I



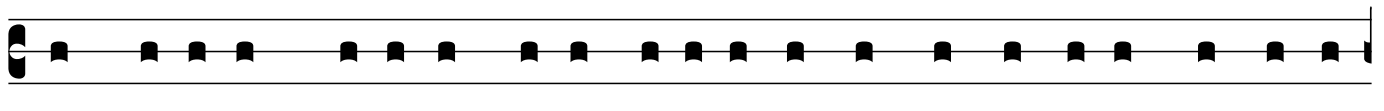
will write them on their minds,” and he adds, “I will remember their sins and



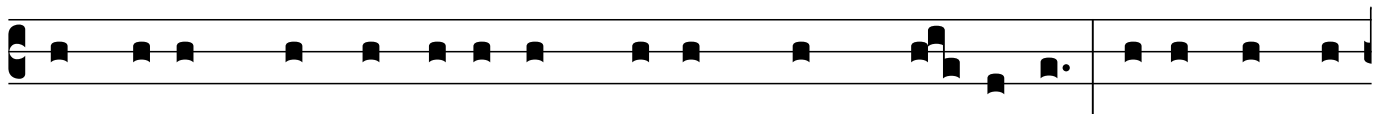
their lawless deeds no more.” Where there is forgiveness of these, there is no



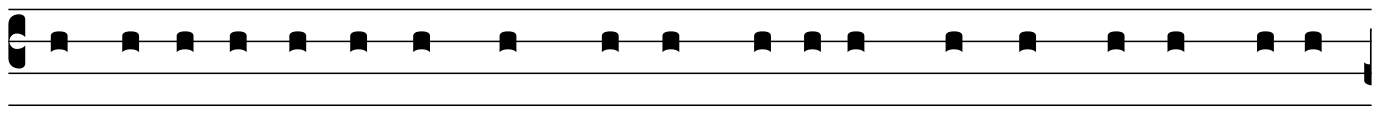
longer an-y offer-ing for sin. Therefore, my brothers and sis-ters, since we



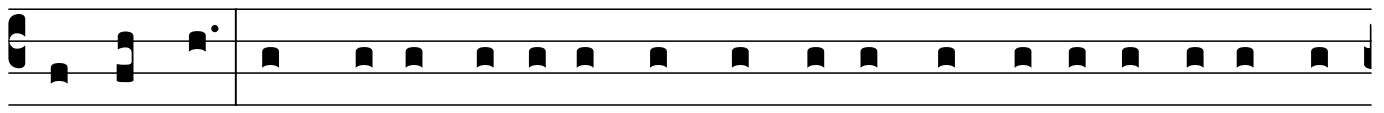
have confi-dence to enter the sanctu- ar-y by the blood of Je-sus, by the new



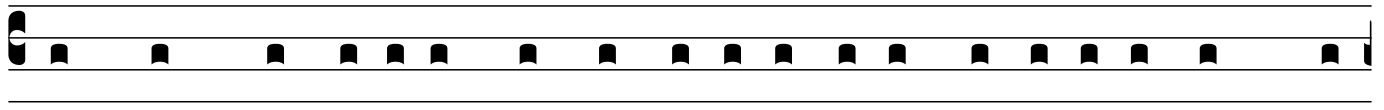
and liv-ing way that he o-pened for us through the curtain Let us hold fast



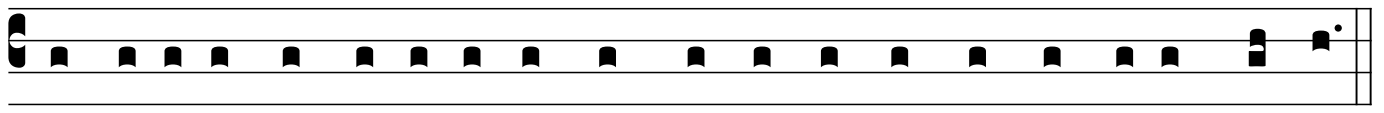
to the confession of our hope without wa-ver-ing, for he who has promised
