

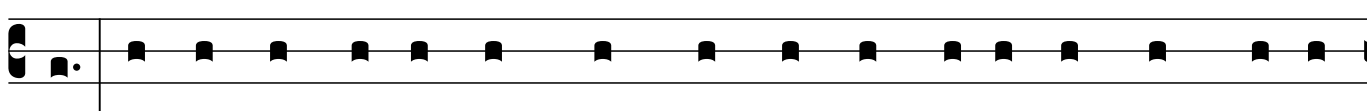

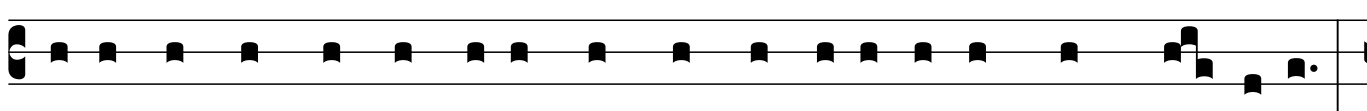

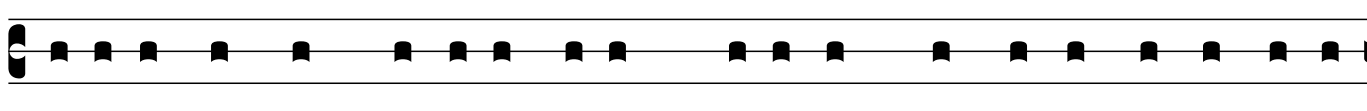
o not be de-ceived; God is not mocked, for you reap what-ev-er you



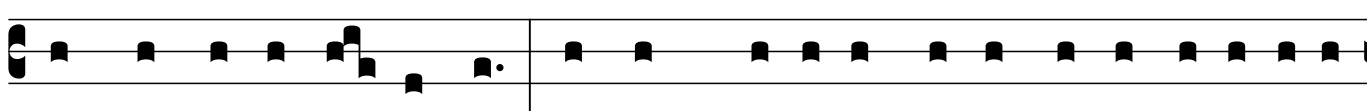
sow. If you sow to your own flesh, you will reap corruption from the flesh,



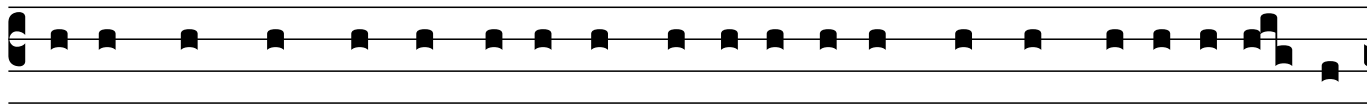
but if you sow to the Spir-it, you will reap e-ternal life from the Spir-it.



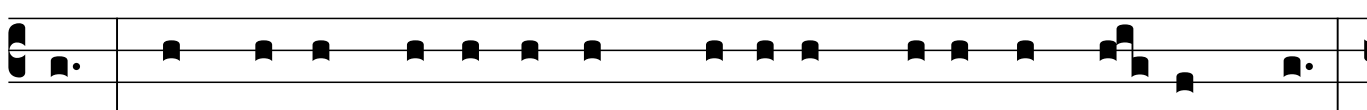
So let us not grow wea-ry in do- ing what is right, for we will reap at harvest



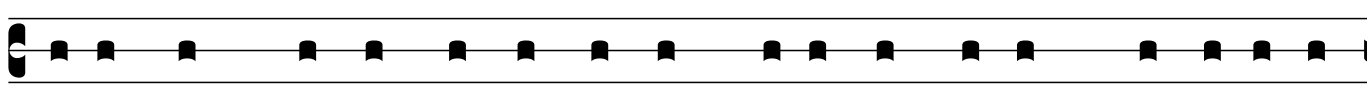
time, if we do not give up. So then, when-ev-er we have an opportu-ni-ty,



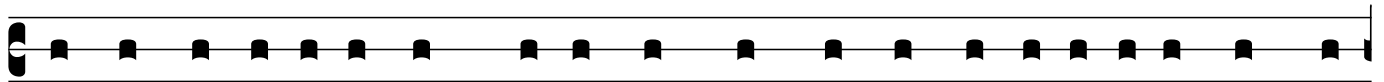
let us work for the good of all and especial-ly for those of the fami-ly of



faith. See what large let-ters I make when I am writ-ing in my own hand!



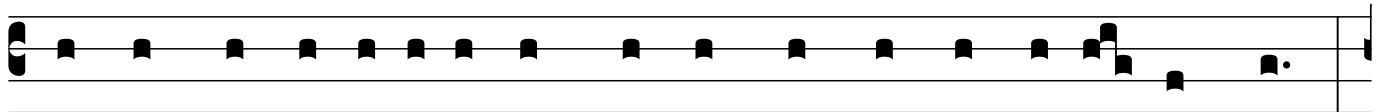
It is those who want to make a good showing in the flesh who try to com-



pel you to be circumcised—only that they may not be perse-cut-ed for the



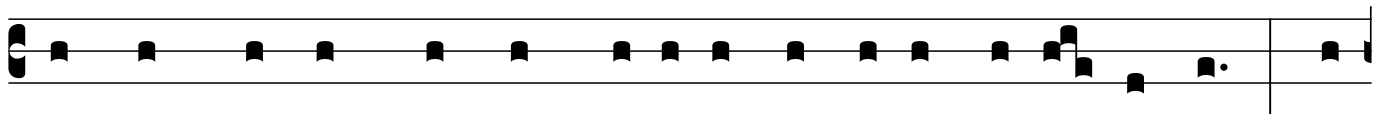
cross of Christ. E-ven the circumcised do not themselves obey the law, but



they want you to be circumcised so that they may boast about your flesh.



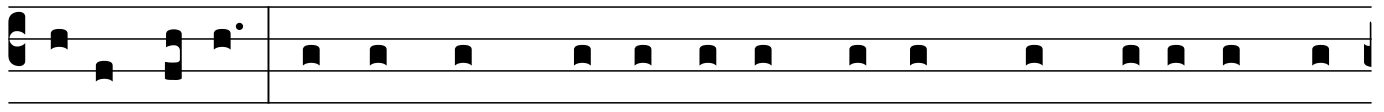
May I nev-er boast of an-ything except the cross of our Lord Je-sus Christ,



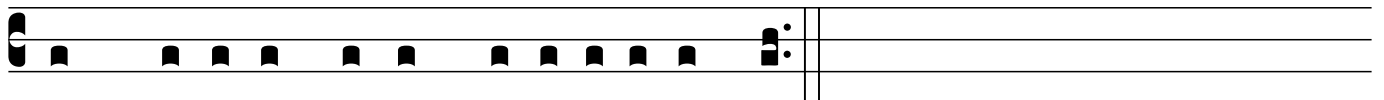
by which the world has been cru-ci-fied to me and I to the world. For
