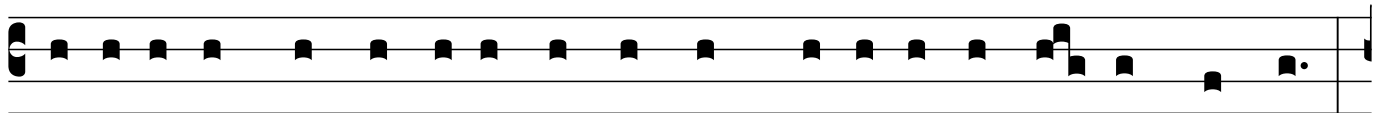


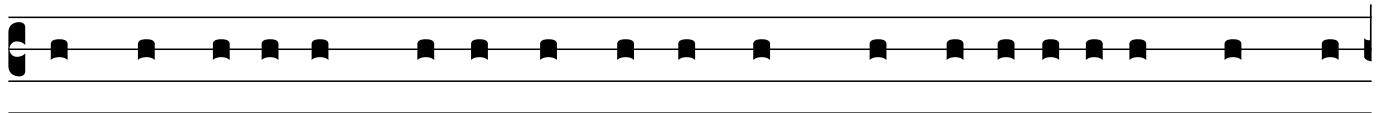
# 2 Corinthians 9:6-15

*Thanksgiving Day*

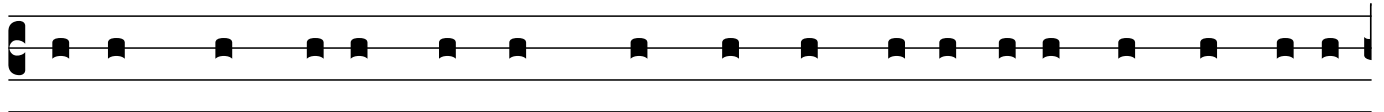
**T**he point is this: the one who sows sparingly will also reap sparingly,

He who supplies seed to the sower and bread for food will supply and



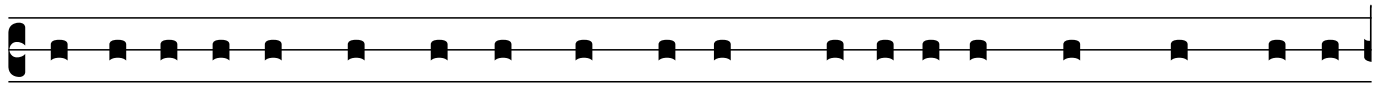
mul-ti-ple your seed for sowing and increase the harvest of your righteousness.



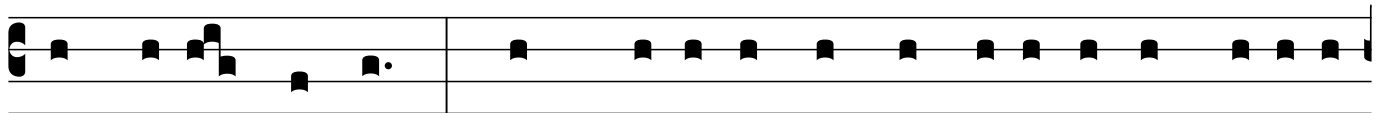
You will be enriched in every way for your great gen-er-os-i-ty, which will



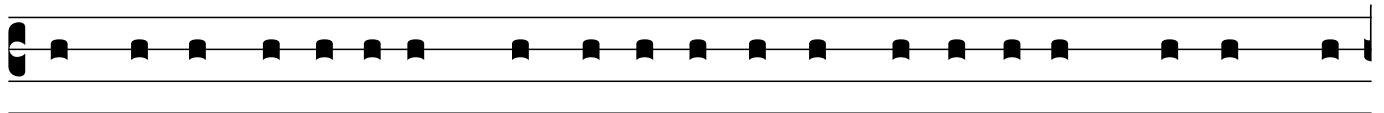

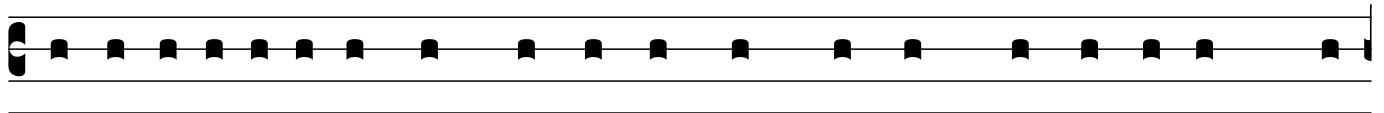
try not only supplies the needs of the saints but also overflows with man-y



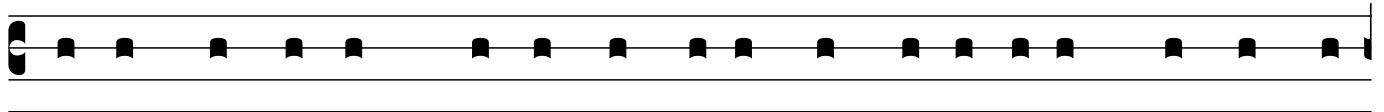

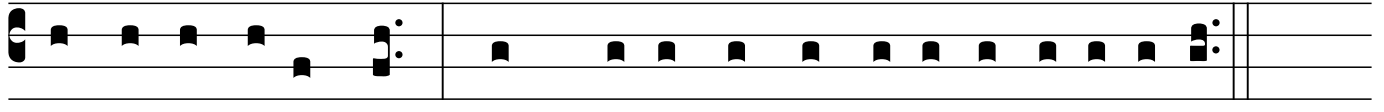
