treasures on earth, where moth and rust consume and where thieves break in

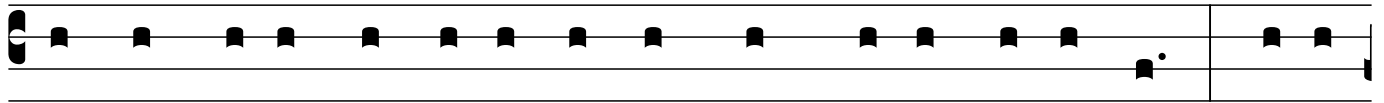
and steal; but store up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where neither

moth nor rust consumes and where thieves do not break in and steal. For

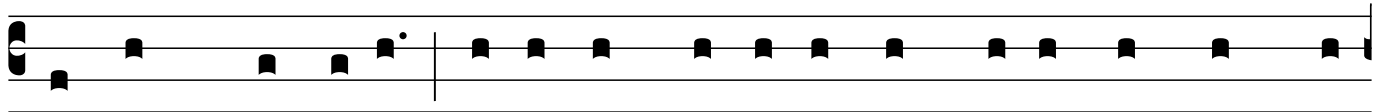
where your treasure is, there your heart will be also. ‘The eye is the lamp of

the bod-y. So, if your eye is healthy, your whole bod-y will be full of light;

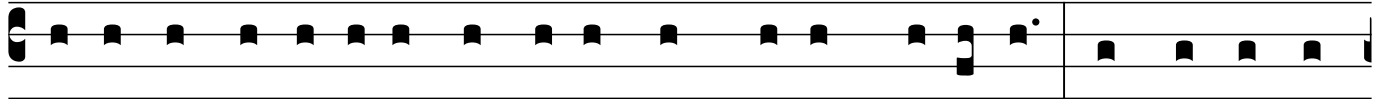
but if your eye is unhealthy, your whole bod-y will be full of darkness.



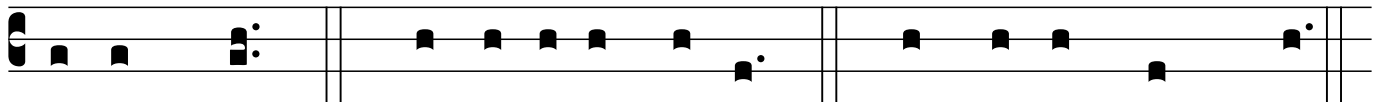
If then the light in you is darkness, how great is the darkness! 'No one
