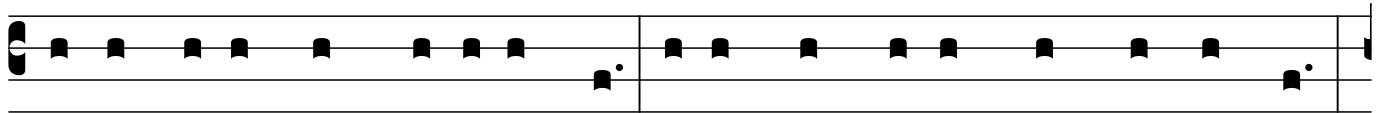
sit-ting by the roadside. When he heard that it was Je-sus of Naz-a-reth, he



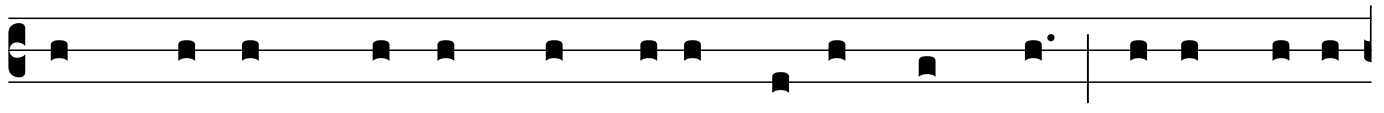
be-gan to shout out and say, 'Je-sus, Son of Da-vid, have mercy on me!' Man-



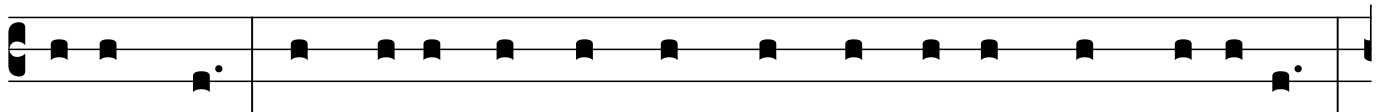
y sternly ordered him to be qui-et, but he cried out e-ven more loudly,



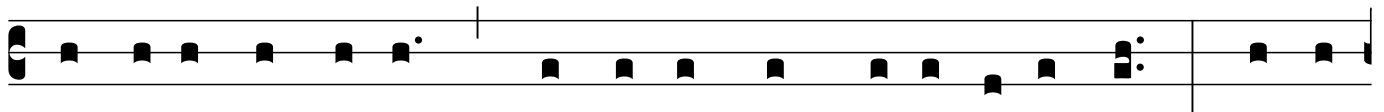
'Son of Da-vid, have mercy on me!' Je-sus stood still and said, 'Call him here.'



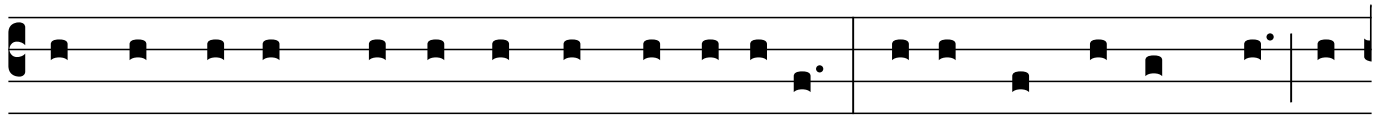
And they called the blind man, say-ing to him, 'Take heart; get up, he is



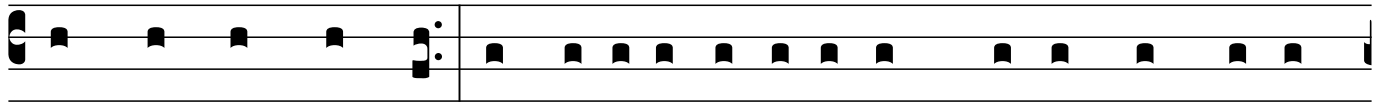
call-ing you.' So throwing off his cloak, he sprang up and came to Je-sus.
