one said to Je-sus, 'I will fol-low you wher-ev-er you go.' And Je-sus

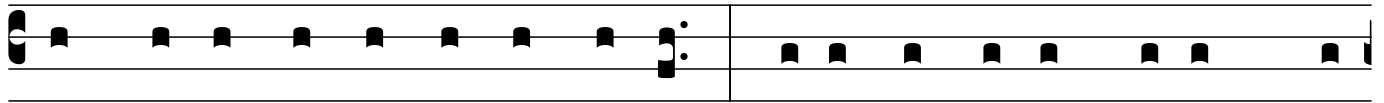
said to him, 'Fox-es have holes, and birds of the air have nests; but the Son

of Man has nowhere to lay his head.' To an-other he said, 'Fol-low me.'

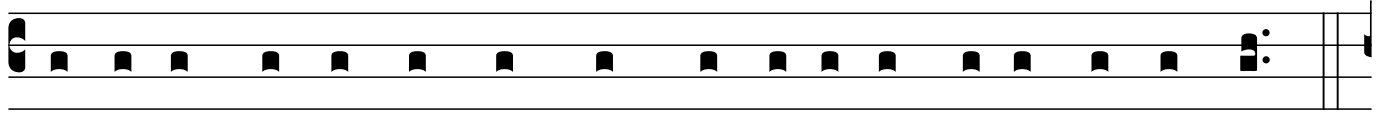
But he said, 'Lord, first let me go and bur-y my father.' But Je-sus said to

him, 'Let the dead bur-y their own dead; but as for you, go and proclaim

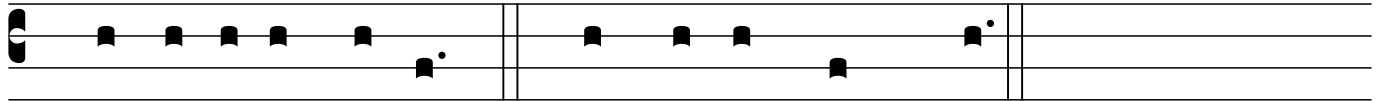
the kingdom of God.' Another said, 'I will fol-low you, Lord; but let me
