XV The Holy Gospel of our Lord Je - sus Christ ac-cord-ing to Luke. Ry. Glo-ry to you, Lord Christ.


When the time came for their purification according to the law of Moses, Jesus' parents / they

brought him up to Jerusalem to pre-sent him to the Lord 23 (as it is written in the law of the


Lord, "Every firstborn male shall be designated as holy to the Lord"), 24 and they offered a sac-

rifice according to what is stat-ed in the law of the Lord, "a pair of turtledoves or two young

pi-geons." ${ }_{25}$ II Now there was a man in Jerusalem whose name was Sim-e - on; this man was

right-eous and de-vout, looking forward to the con-so- la-tion of Is- ra- el, and the Holy Spirit

rest-ed on him. 26 It had been revealed to him by the Holy Spirit that he would not see death be-

fore he had seen the Lord's Mes-si-ah. 27 Guid-ed by the Spir-it, Simeon came into the tem -

ple; and when the par-ents brought in the child Je-sus, to do for him what was cus-tom-ar - y

un-der the law, 28 Simeon took him in his arms and praised God, say-ing, 29 "Mas - ter, now

you are dis-mis-sing your ser-vant in peace, according to your word; 30 for my eyes have seen

your sal-va-tion, 31 which you have pre-pared in the pres-ence of all peo-ples, 32 a light for reve -

lation to the Gentiles and for glory to your people Is - ra - el." 33 II And the child's father and

mother were amazed at what was being said a-bout him. 34 Then Simeon blessed them and said

to his moth-er Mar-y, "This child is destined for the falling and the rising of many in Israel,

and to be a sign that will be op-posed 35 so that the inner thoughts of man-y will be re-vealed-

and a sword will pierce your own soul too." ${ }_{36}$ II There was also a prophet, Anna the daughter

of Phanuel, of the tribe of Ash-er. She was of a great age, having lived with her husband seven

years after her marriage, 37 then as a widow to the age of eight-y-four. She never left the temple

but worshiped there with fasting and prayer night and day. 38 At that moment she came, and

began to praise God and to speak about the child to all who were looking for the redemption

of Je- ru- sa-lem. ${ }^{39}$ II When they had finished ev'-ry-thing re-quired by the law of the Lord,

they returned to Galilee, to their own town of Naz- a - reth. 40 The child grew and became

strong, filled with wis-dom; and the fa-vor of God was up - on him.
