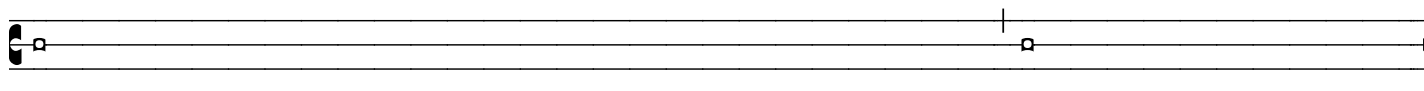


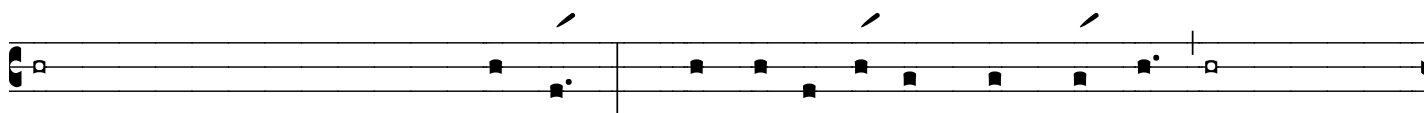

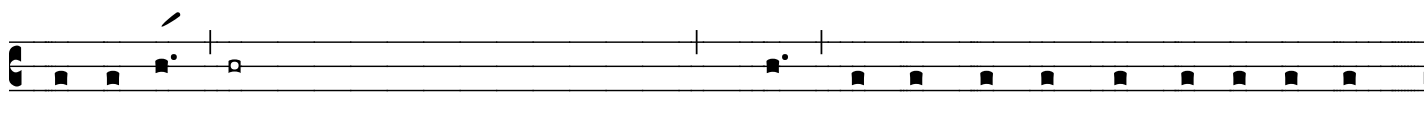
Now as they went on their way, Jesus entered a certain village, where a woman named



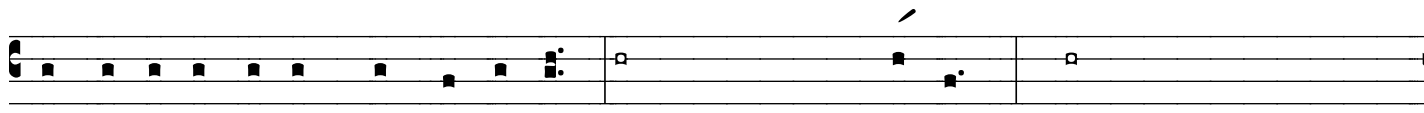
Martha welcomed him into her home. ³⁹ She had a sis-ter named Mar-y, who sat at the



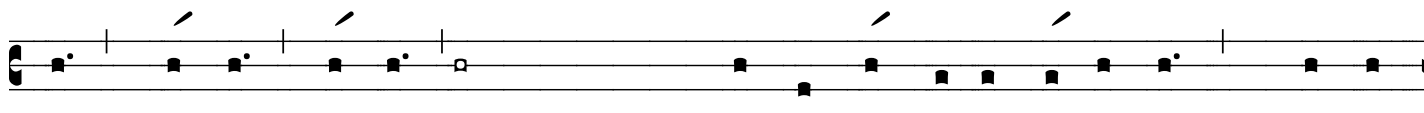
Lord's feet and listened to what he was say-ing. ⁴⁰ But Mar-tha was dis-tract-ed by her



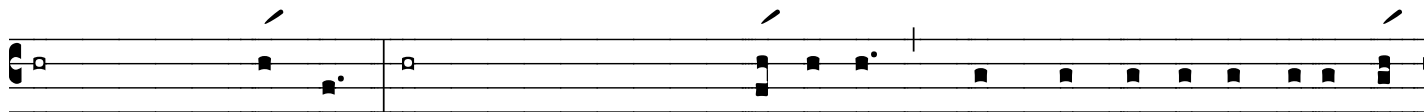
man-y tasks; so she came to him and asked, “Lord, do you not care that my sis-ter has
