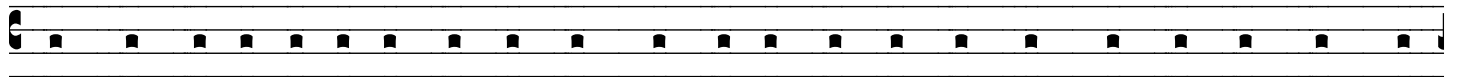
Oth-er-wise, when he has laid a foundation and is not a-ble to fin-ish, all who see it will be -



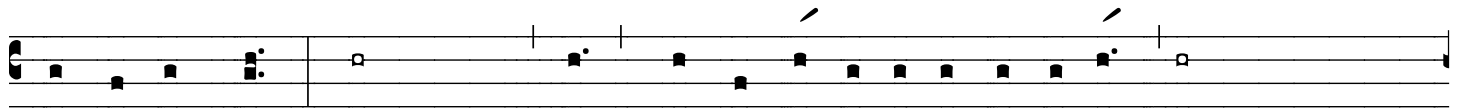
gin to rid - i-cule him, 30 say-ing, ‘This fellow began to build and was not able to fin-ish.’ 31 Or



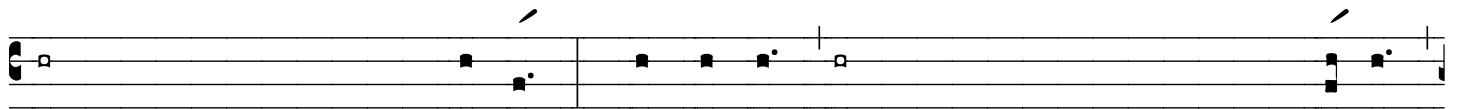
what king, going out to wage war a-gainst an-oth-er king, will not sit down first and con-sid -



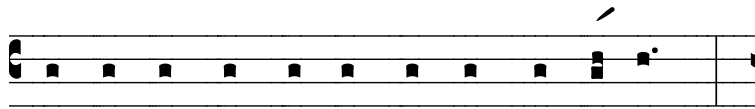
er wheth-er he is a-ble with ten thou-sand to op-pose the one who comes a-gainst him with



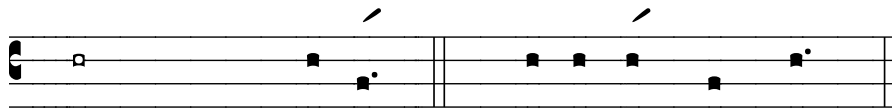
twen-ty thou-sand? 32 If he cannot, then, while the oth-er is still far a - way, he sends a delega -
