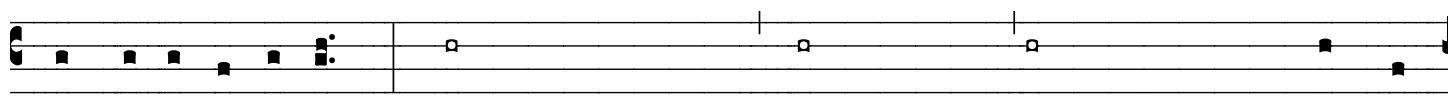

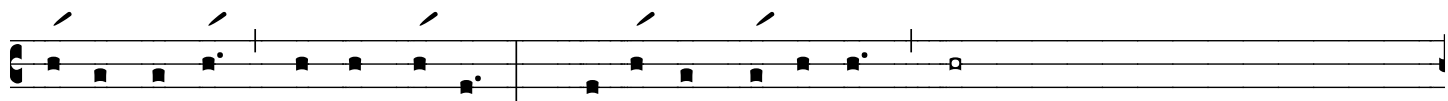
James and John, the sons of Zebe-dee, came for-ward to Je-sus and said to him, “Teach-er,



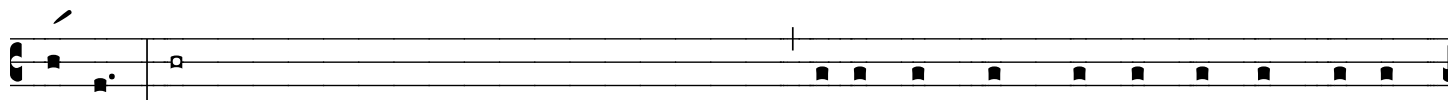
we want you to do for us whatever we ask of you.” **36** And he said to them, “What is it you



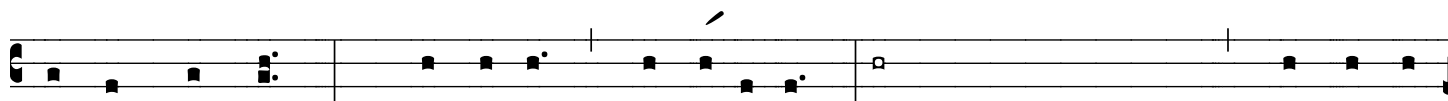
want me to do for you?” **37** And they said to him, “Grant us to sit, one at your right hand and



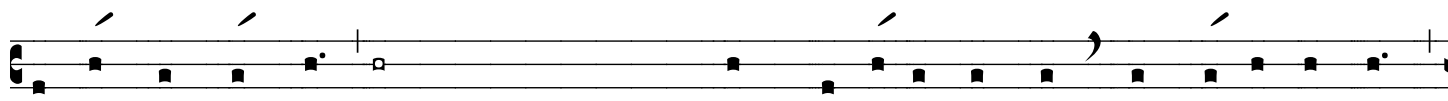
one at your left, in your glo-ry.” **38** But Je-sus said to them, “You do not know what you are



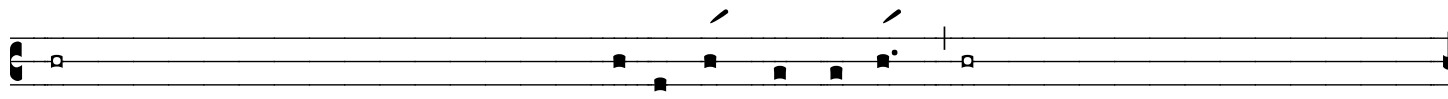
ask-ing. Are you able to drink the cup that I drink, or be bap-tized with the bap-tism that I



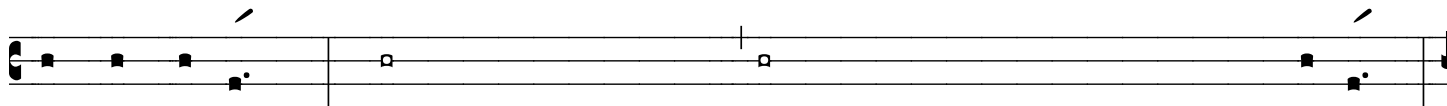
am bap-tized with?” **39** They re-plied, “We are a - ble.” Then Jesus said to them, “The cup that



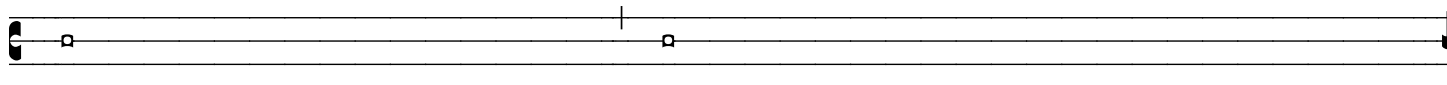
I drink you will drink; and with the baptism with which I am bap-tized, you will be bap-tized;



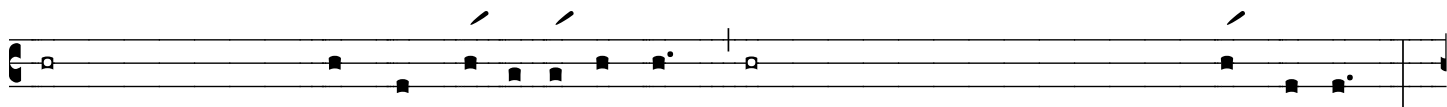
40 but to sit at my right hand or at my left is not mine to grant, but it is for those for whom it



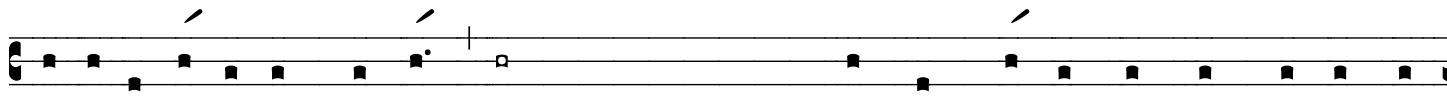
has been pre-pared.” 41 When the ten heard this, they began to be angry with James and John.



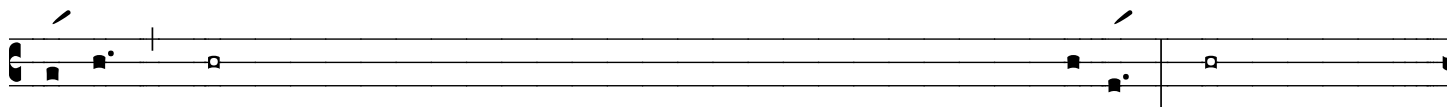
42 So Jesus called them and said to them, “You know that among the Gentiles those whom they



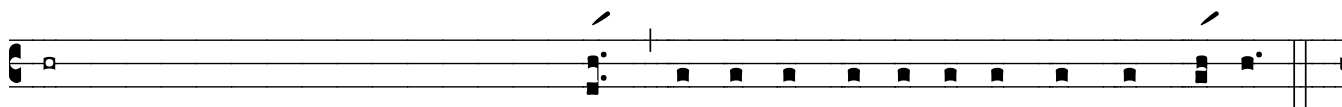
recognize as their rul - ers lord it o - ver them, and their great ones are tyrants o - ver them. 43



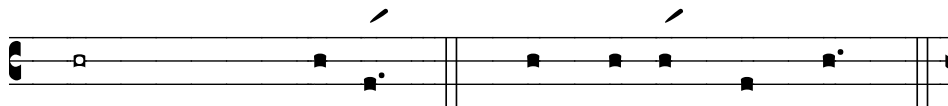
But it is not so a - mong you; but whoever wishes to be-come great a-mong you must be your
