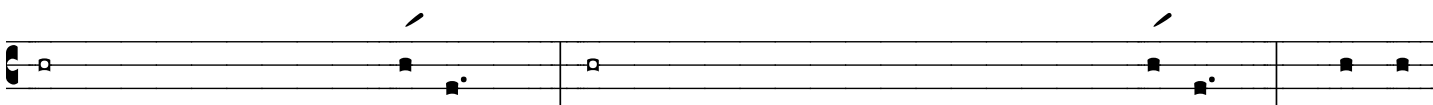
Teaching in the temple, Jesus said, “Beware of the scribes, who like to walk a-round in long



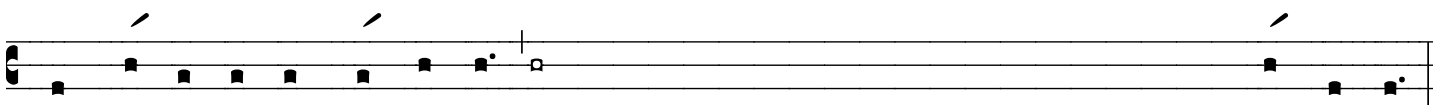

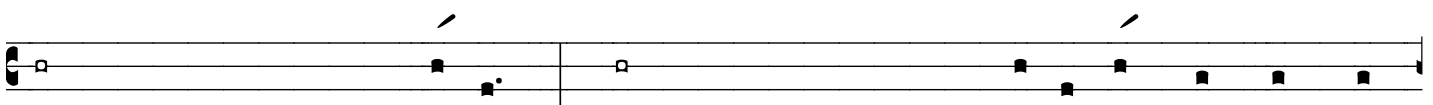
the synagogues and places of honor at ban-quets! ⁴⁰ They devour widows’ houses and for the



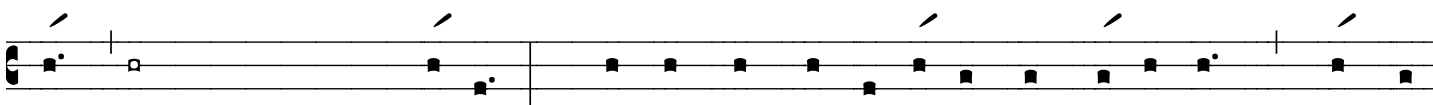
sake of appearance say long prayers. They will receive the greater condem-na-tion.” ⁴¹ He sat



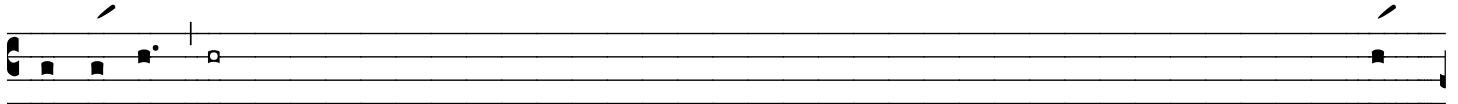

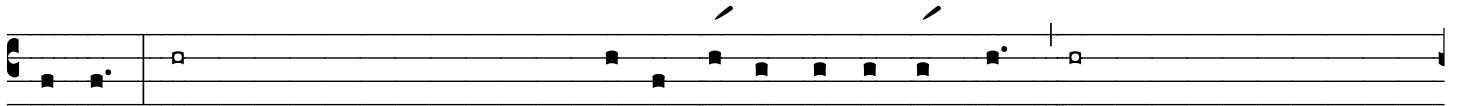
Many rich people put in large sums. ⁴² A poor widow came and put in two small cop - per



coins, which are worth a pen-ny. ⁴³ Then he called his dis-ci-ples and said to them, “Tru - ly



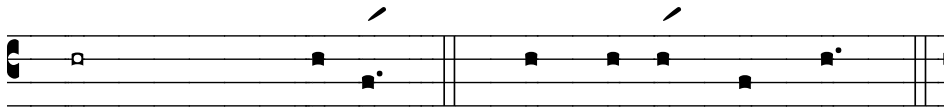
I tell you, this poor widow has put in more than all those who are contributing to the treas -
