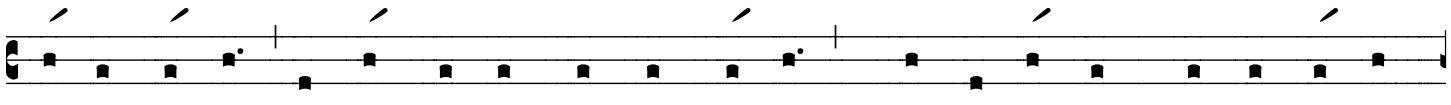
Some Sadducees, those who say there is no res-ur-rec-tion, came to Je-sus <sup>28</sup> and asked him a



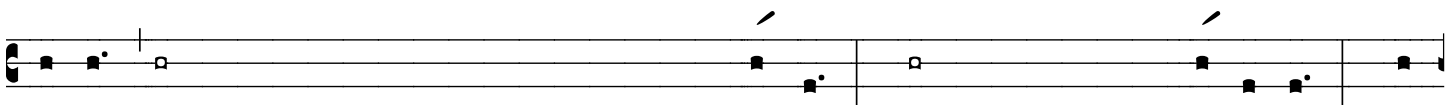
ques-tion, “Teach-er, Moses wrote for us that if a man’s brother dies, leaving a wife but no chil-



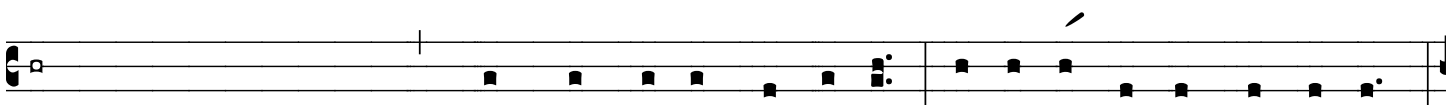
dren, the man shall marry the widow and raise up children for his broth-er. <sup>29</sup> Now there were



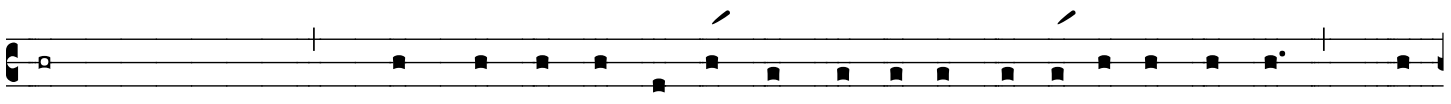
sev-en broth-ers; the first mar-ried, and died child-less; <sup>30</sup> then the sec-ond <sup>31</sup> and the third mar-



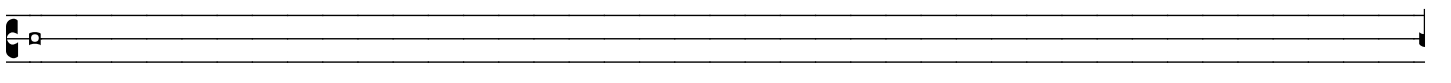
ried her, and so in the same way all seven died child-less. <sup>32</sup> Finally the woman al-so died. <sup>33</sup> In



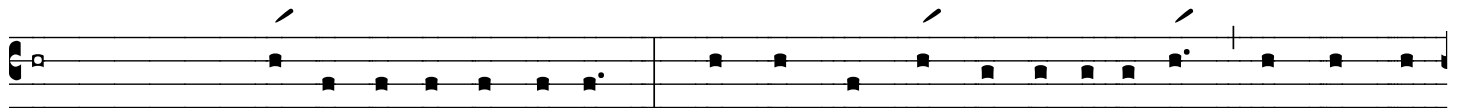
the resurrection, therefore, whose wife will the wom-an be? For the sev-en had mar-ried her.”



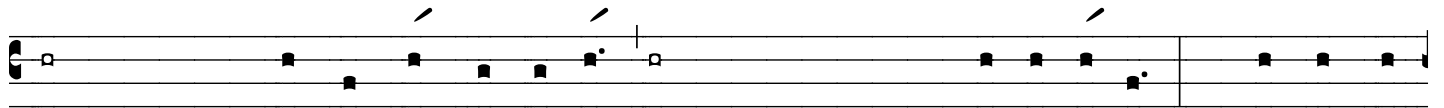
<sup>34</sup> Jesus said to them, “Those who be-long to this age mar-ry and are giv-en in mar-riage; <sup>35</sup> but



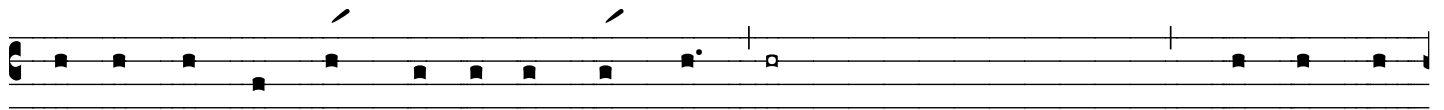
those who are considered worthy of a place in that age and in the resurrection from the dead



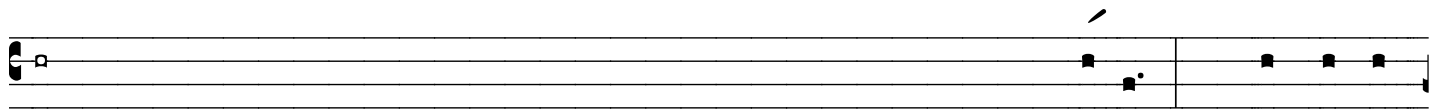
neither marry nor are giv-en in mar-riage. <sup>36</sup> In-deed they can-not die an-y-more, be-cause they



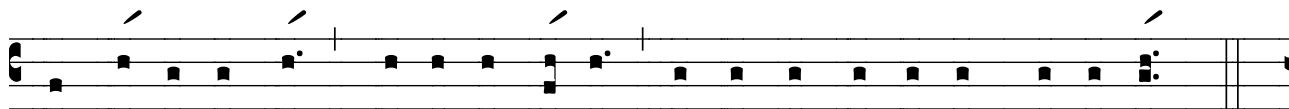
are like angels and are chil-dren of God, being children of the res-ur-rec-tion. <sup>37</sup> And the fact



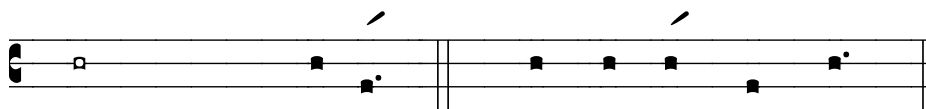
that the dead are raised Mo-ses him-self showed, in the story about the bush, where he speaks
