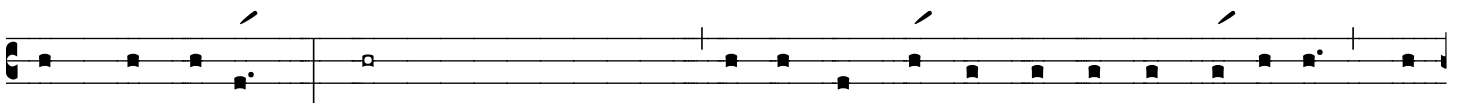
[Soon after healing the centurion's slave,] Jesus went to a town called Nain, and his disciples and



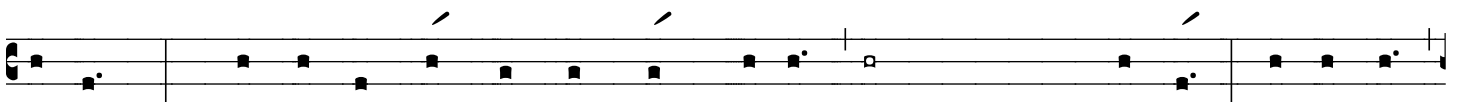
a large crowd went with him. **12** As he ap-proached the gate of the town, a man who had died was



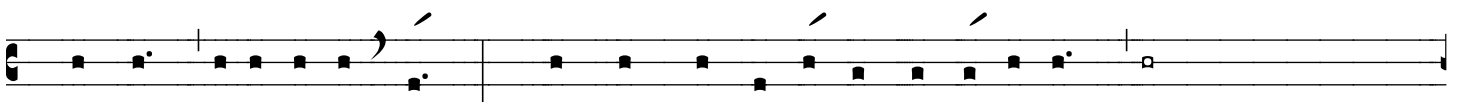
be-ing car-ried out. He was his mo-ther's on-ly son, and she was a wid-ow; and with her was a large



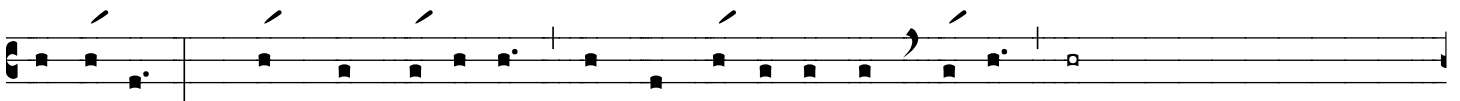
crowd from the town. **13** When the Lord saw her, he had com-pas-sion for her and said to her, “Do



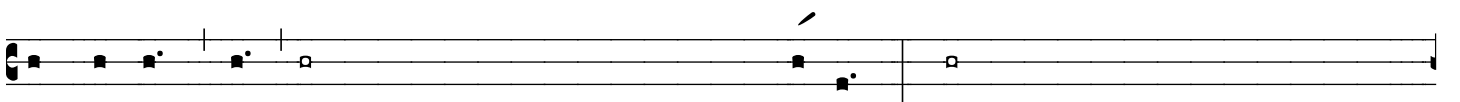
not weep.” **14** Then he came for-ward and touched the bier, and the bearers stood still. And he said,
