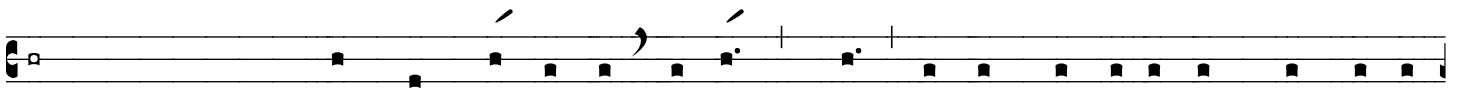
When the days drew near for Je-sus to be tak-en up, he set his face to go to Je-ru- sa- lem. *52* And



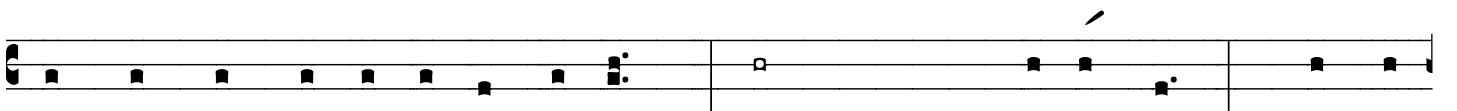
he sent messengers a-head of him. On their way they entered a village of the Sa-mar-i- tans to make



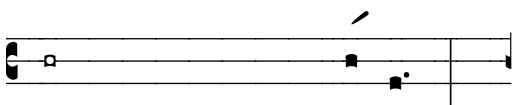
read-y for him; *53* but they did not re-ceive him, because his face was set toward Je-ru- sa- lem. *54*



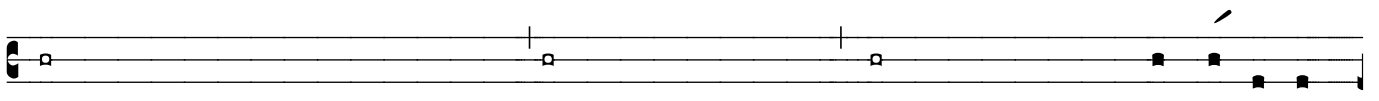
When his disciples James and John saw it, they said, “Lord, do you want us to com-mand fire to



come down from heav-en and con-sume them?” *55* But he turned and re-buked them. *56* Then they



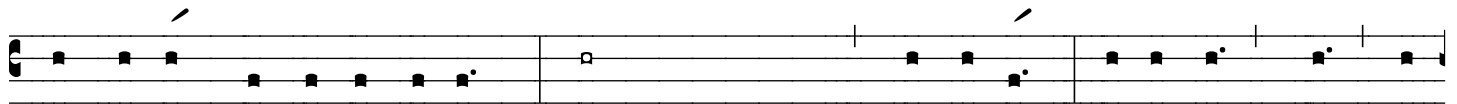
went on to another vil - lage.



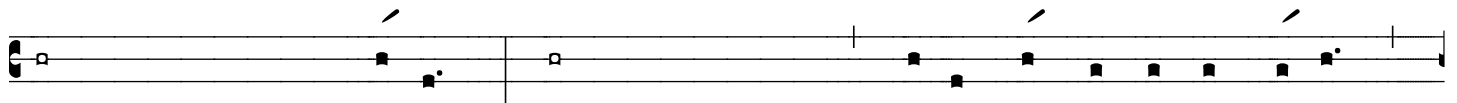
57 As they were going along the road, someone said to him, “I will follow you wher-ev-er you



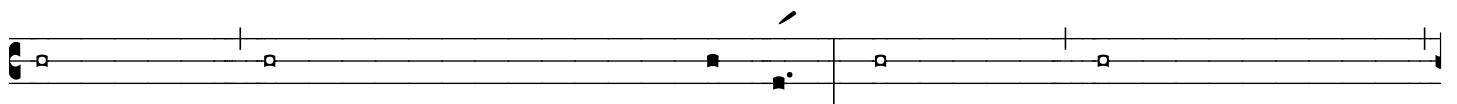
go.” *58* And Jesus said to him, “Fox-es have holes, and birds of the air have nests; but the Son of



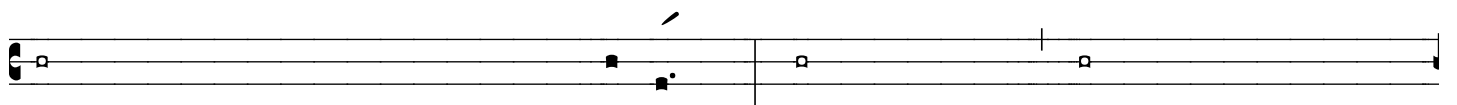
Man has no-where to lay his head.” 59 To another he said, “Fol-low me.” But he said, “Lord, first



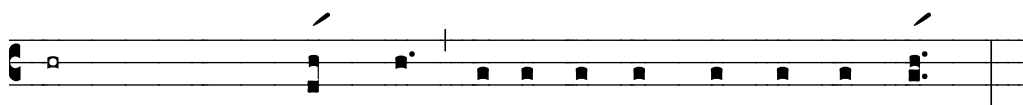
let me go and bury my fa - ther.” 60 But Jesus said to him, “Let the dead bur - y their own dead;



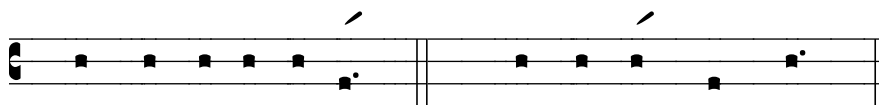
but as for you, go and proclaim the kingdom of God.” 61 Another said, “I will follow you, Lord;
