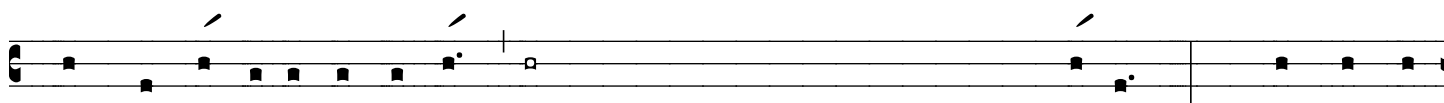
Mary stood weeping outside the tomb. As she wept, she bent o - ver to look in-to the tomb; **12** and



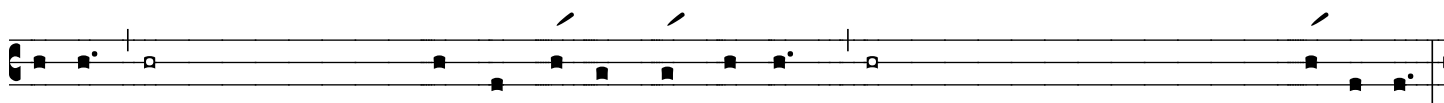
she saw two angels in white, sitting where the body of Jesus had been lying, one at the head and



the other at the feet. **13** They said to her, “Wom-an, why are you weep-ing?” She said to them,



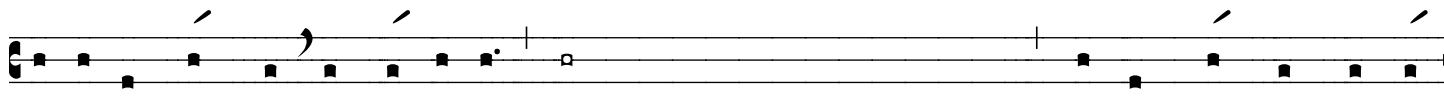
“They have tak-en a-way my Lord, and I do not know where they have laid him.” **14** When she had



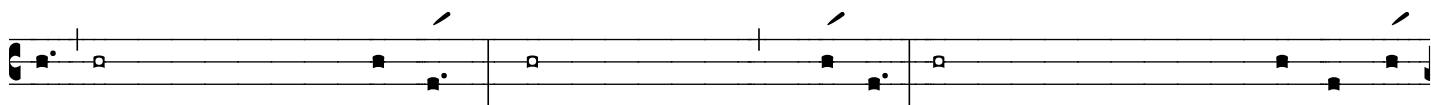
said this, she turned around and saw Je-sus stand-ing there, but she did not know that it was Je-sus.



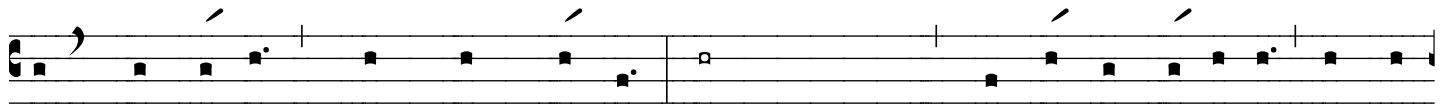
**15** Jesus said to her, “Wom-an, why are you weep-ing? Whom are you look-ing for?” Supposing him



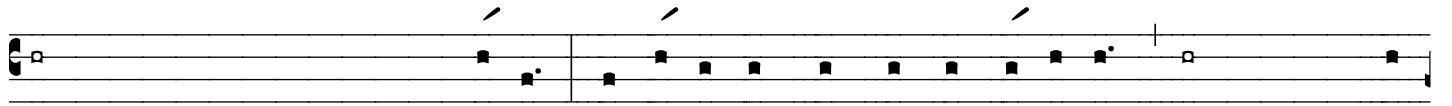
to be the gard-’ner, she said to him, “Sir, if you have carried him away, tell me where you have laid



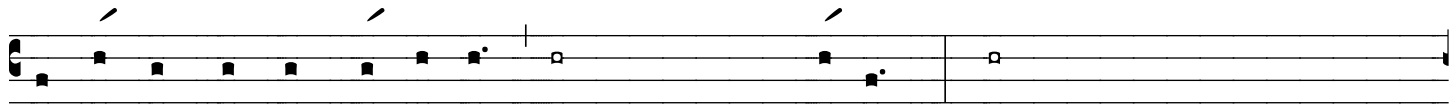
him, and I will take him a-way.” **16** Jesus said to her, “Mar-y!” She turned and said to him in Heb -



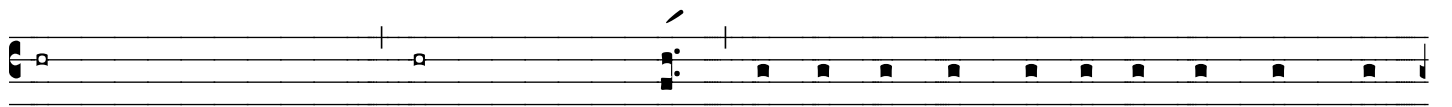
rew, "Rab-bou-ni!" (which means Teach-er). 17 Jesus said to her, "Do not hold on to me, be-cause



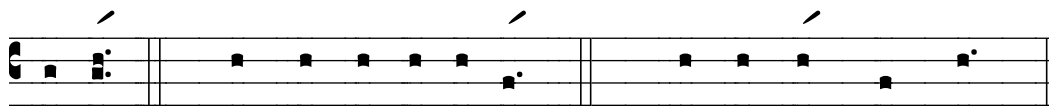
I have not yet ascended to the Fa-ther. But go to my broth-ers and say to them, 'I am ascend - ing
