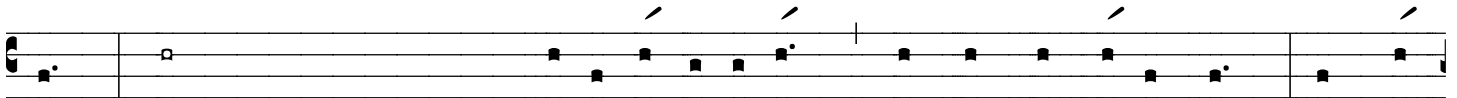
Thomas (who was called the Twin), one of the twelve, was not with them when Je-sus came. **25** So the



other disciples told him, “We have seen the Lord.” But he said to them, “Unless I see the mark of the



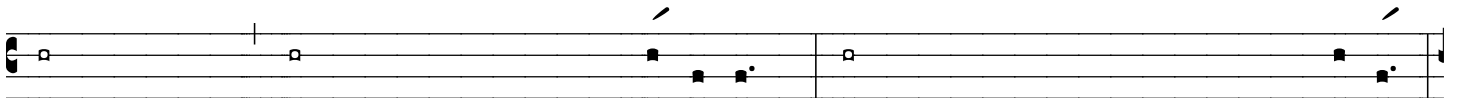
nails in his hands, and put my finger in the mark of the nails and my hand in his side, I will not be -



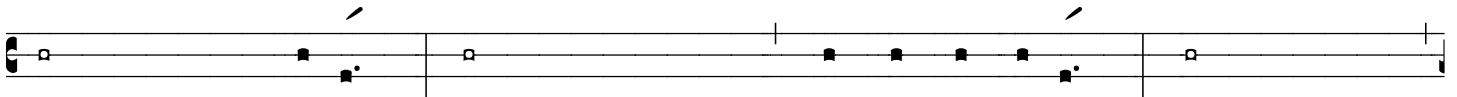
lieve.” **26** A week later his disciples were a-gain in the house, and Tho-mas was with them. Al-though



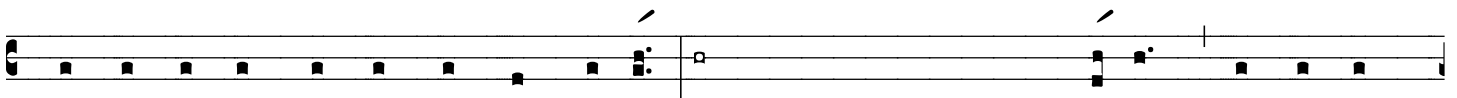
the doors were shut, Jesus came and stood a-mong them and said, “Peace be with you.” **27** Then he



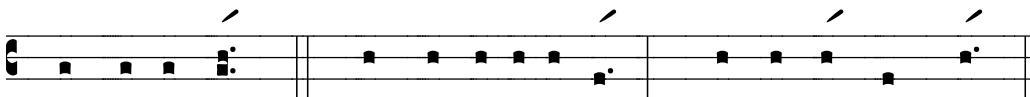
said to Thomas, “Put your finger here and see my hands. Reach out your hand and put it in my side.
