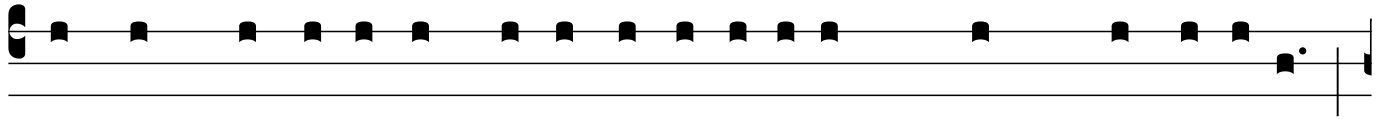
a priest for ev-er after the order of Melchiz-e-dek.” In the days of his flesh,



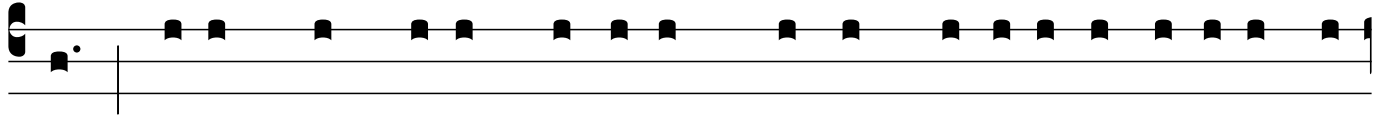
Je-sus offered up prayers and suppli-cations, with loud cries and tears, to him



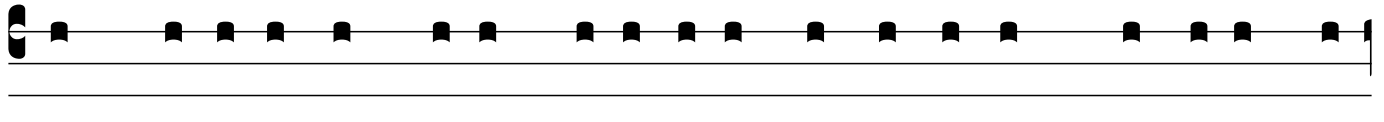
who was able to save him from death, and he was heard for his godly fear.



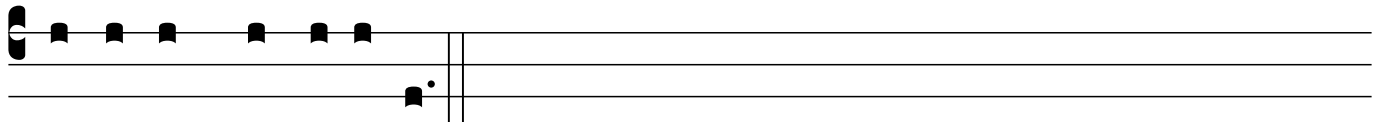
Although he was a Son, he learned o-be-di- ence through what he suffered;
