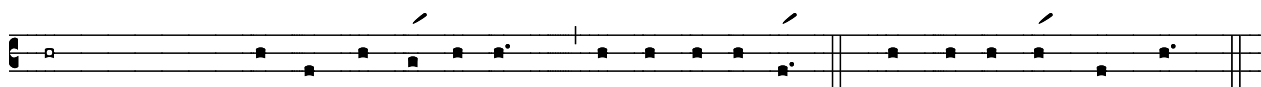


Wednesday in Holy Week
(John 13:21-32 NRSV) (ABC RCL)

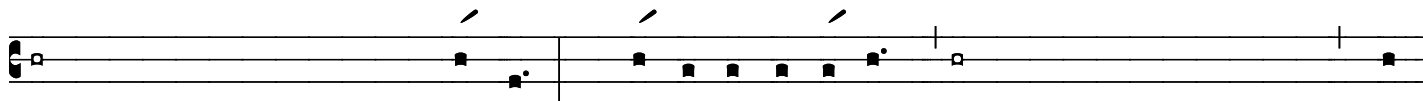


✠ The Holy Gospel of our Lord Je - sus Christ ac-cord-ing to John. ✠ *Glo - ry to you, Lord Christ.*

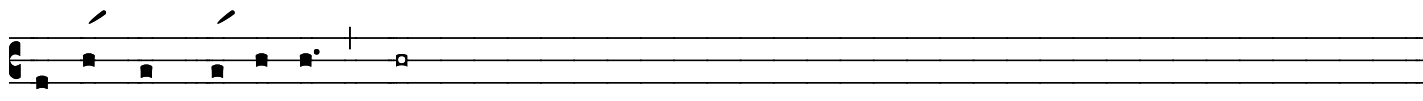
At supper with his friends, *or* [After saying this] Jesus was troubled in spirit, and declared,



“Ver-y tru-ly, I tell you, one of you will be-tray me.” ²² The dis-ci-ples looked at one an-oth - er,



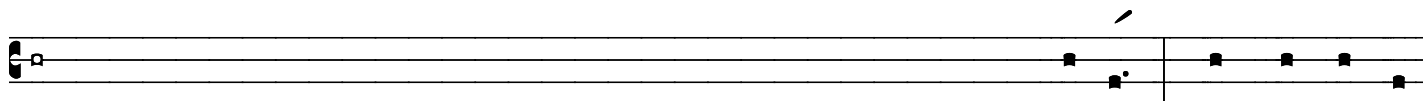
uncertain of whom he was speak-ing. ²³ One of his dis-ci - ples—the one whom Jesus loved—was



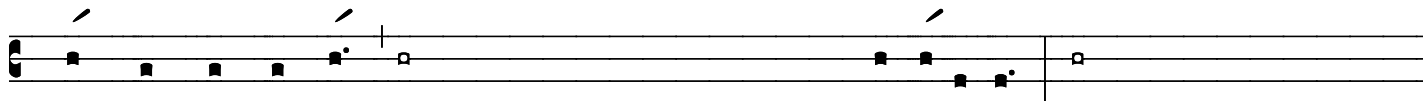
re-clin-ing next to him; ²⁴ Simon Peter therefore motioned to him to ask Jesus of whom he was



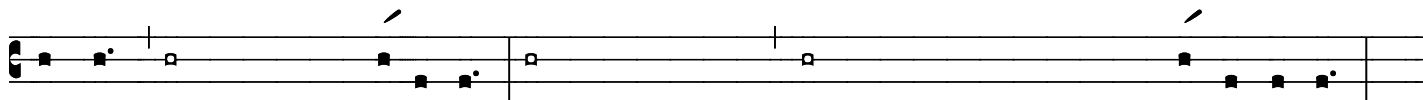
speak-ing. ²⁵ So while re-clin-ing next to Je-sus, he asked him, “Lord, who is it?” ²⁶ Jesus answered,



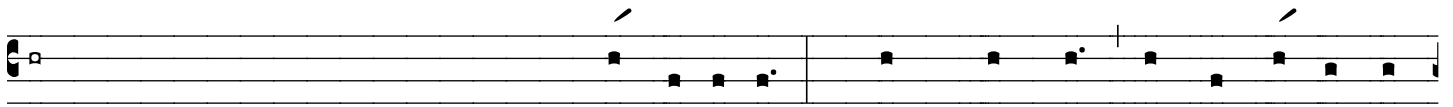
“It is the one to whom I give this piece of bread when I have dipped it in the dish.” So when he had



dipped the piece of bread, he gave it to Judas son of Simon Is-car-i - ot. ²⁷ After he received the piece



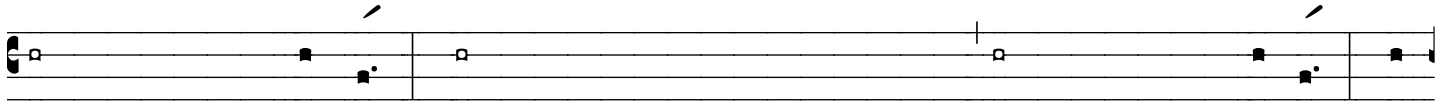
of bread, Satan entered in-to him. Jesus said to him, “Do quickly what you are go-ing to do.” ²⁸



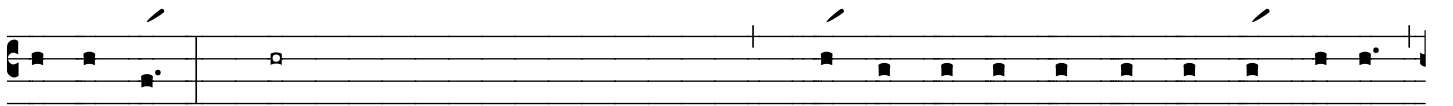
Now no one at the table knew why he said this to him. 29 Some thought that, be-cause Ju-das had



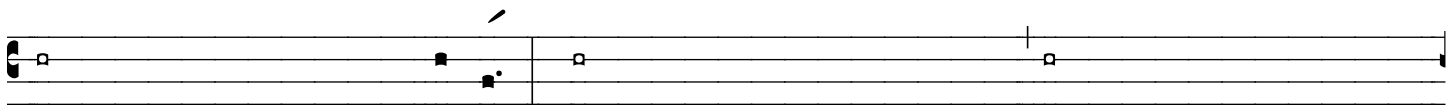
the com-mon purse, Jesus was telling him, “Buy what we need for the fes-ti-val”; or, that he should



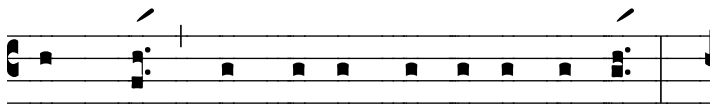
give something to the poor. 30 So, after receiving the piece of bread, he immediately went out. And



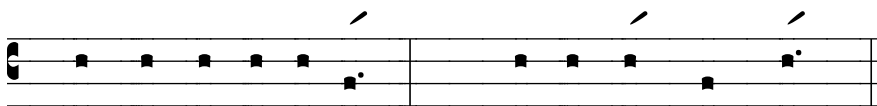
it was night. ¶ 31 When he had gone out, Jesus said, “Now the Son of Man has been glo - ri - fied,
