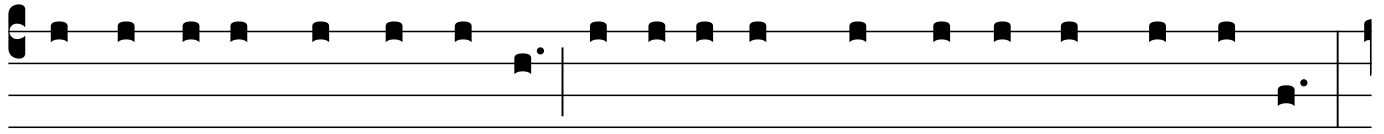


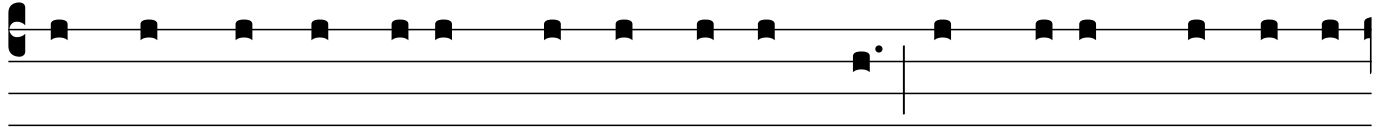
Isaiah 55:1-11

Lesson 6: Salvation offered freely to all

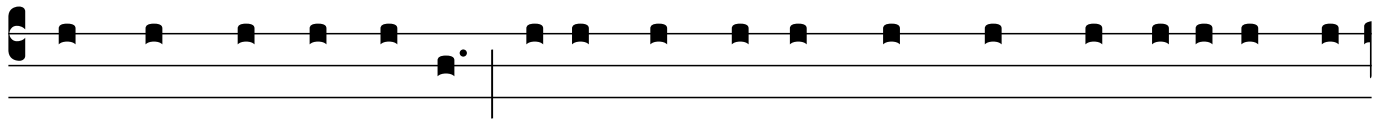
Hear, every-one who thirsts; come to the wa-ters; and you who have

you an everlast-ing cov-e-nant, my steadfast, sure love for Da-vid. See, I made



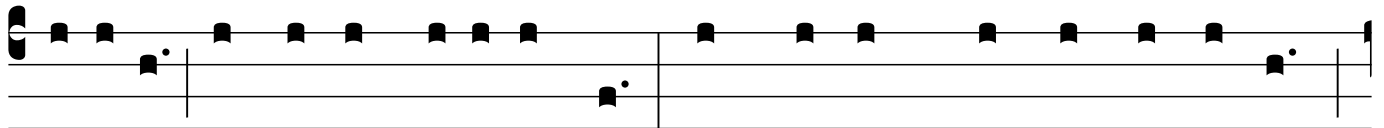
him a witness to the peoples, a leader and commander for the peoples.



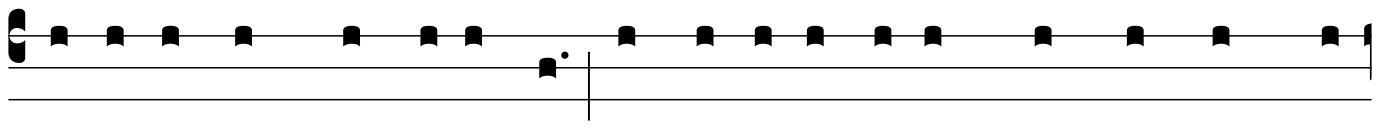
Now you shall call nations that you do not know, and nations that do not



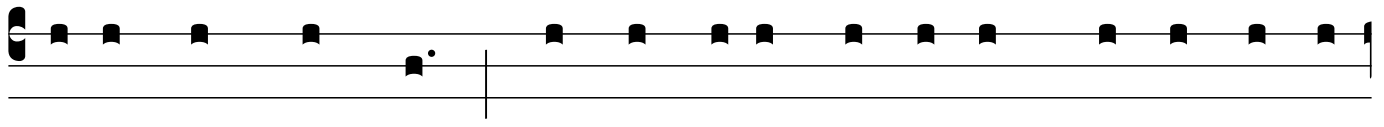
know you shall run to you, because of the Lord your God, the Ho-ly One of



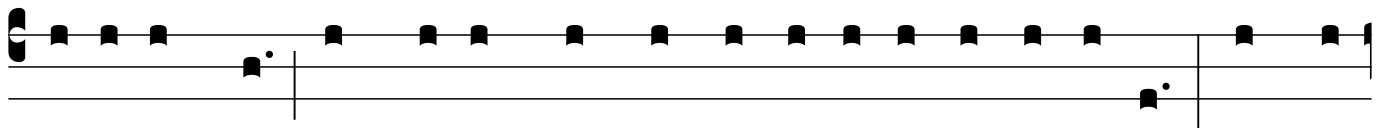
Isra-el, for he has glo-ri-fied you. Seek the Lord while he may be found;



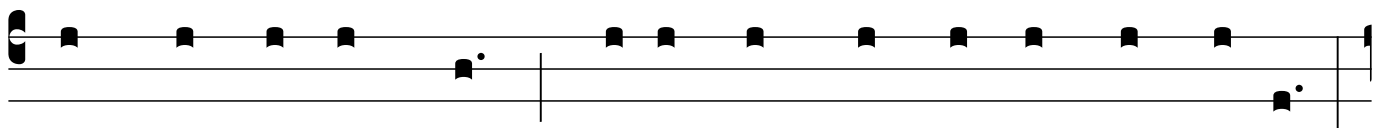
call up-on him while he is near; let the wicked forsake their way and the



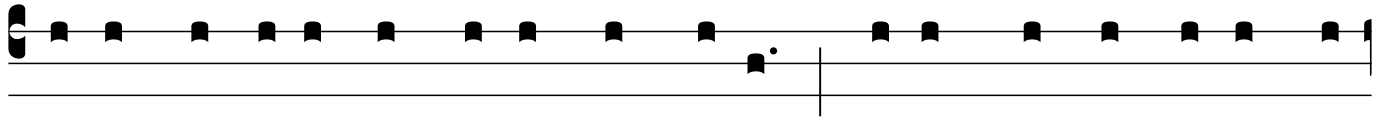
unrighteous their thoughts; let them re-turn to the Lord, that he may have



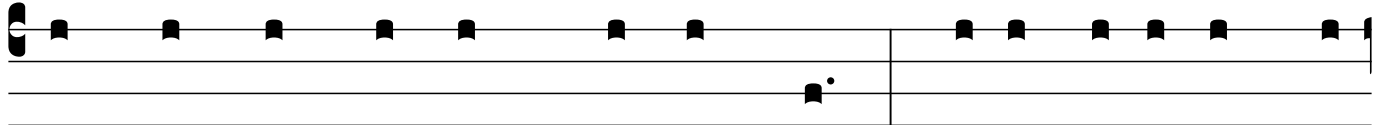
mercy on them, and to our God, for he will a-bundantly pardon. For my



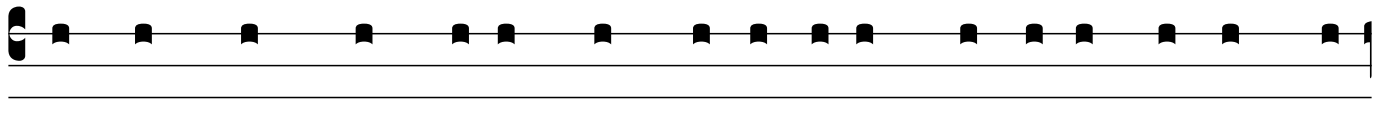
thoughts are not your thoughts, nor are your ways my ways, says the Lord.



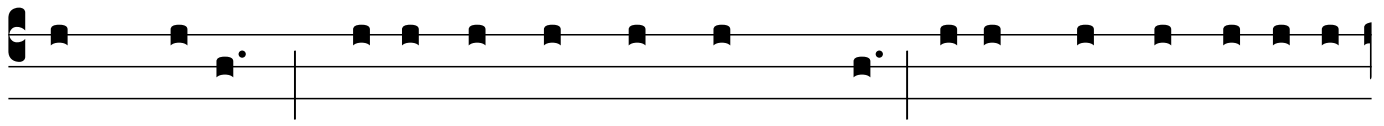
For as the heavens are higher than the earth, so are my ways higher than



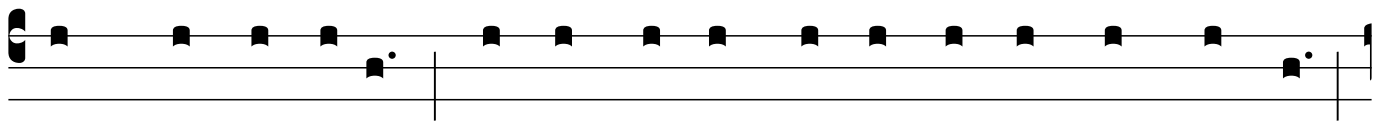
your ways and my thoughts than your thoughts. For as the rain and the



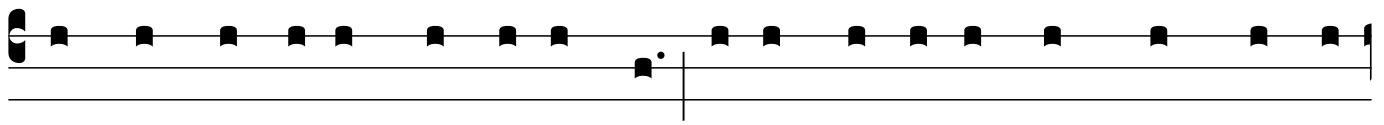
snow come down from heaven and do not re-turn there until they have wa-



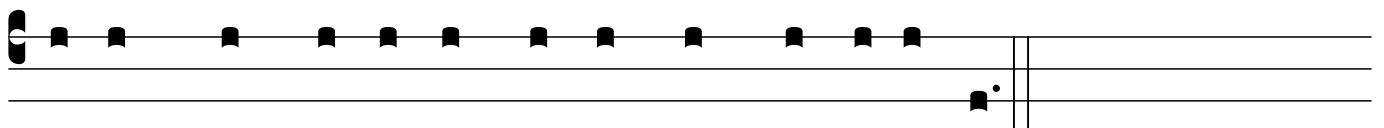
tered the earth, mak-ing it bring forth and sprout, giv-ing seed to the sower
