



Epiphany Proclamation

Announcement of Easter and the Moveable Feasts



Dear friends in Christ, the glo-ry of the Lord has shone up-on us,
and shall ev-er be man-i-fest among us, until the day of his re-turn. Through
the rhythms of times and seasons let us cel-ebrate the myster-ies of salvation.
Let us re-call the year's culmi-nation, the Paschal Trid-u-um of the Lord:
his last supper, his cru-ci-fixion, his bur-i-al, and his ris-ing cel-ebrat-ed
between the evening of the xth day of April and the evening of the xth
day of April. Each Easter – as on each Sunday – the Ho-ly Church makes
pre-sent the great and sav-ing deed by which Christ has for ev-er conquered




sin and death. From Easter are reckoned all the days we keep ho-ly.




Ash Wednesday, the be-gin-ning of Lent, will occur on the xth day of Feb-

day of May. Pente-cost, the joyful conclusion of the season of Easter,




will be cel-ebrat-ed on the xth day of May. And, this year the First Sunday




of Advent will be on the xth day of De-cember. Likewise the pilgrim Church



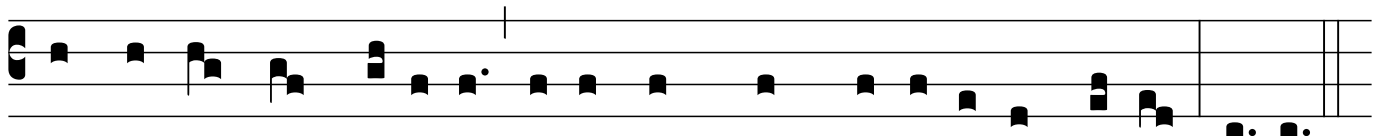
proclaims the passo-ver of Christ in the feasts of the ho-ly Mother of God,
