lev-el place, with a great crowd of his dis-ciples and a great mul-ti-tude of

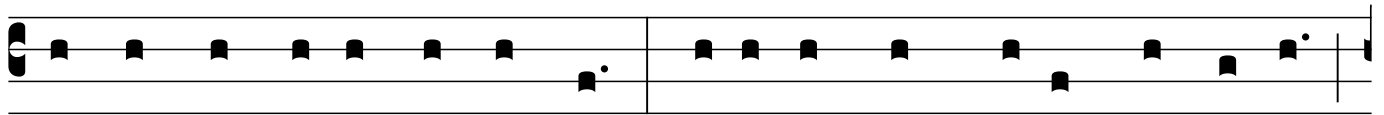
people from all Ju-de- a, Je-ru-sa-lem, and the coast of Tyre and Si-don.

They had come to hear him and to be healed of their dis-eas-es; and those

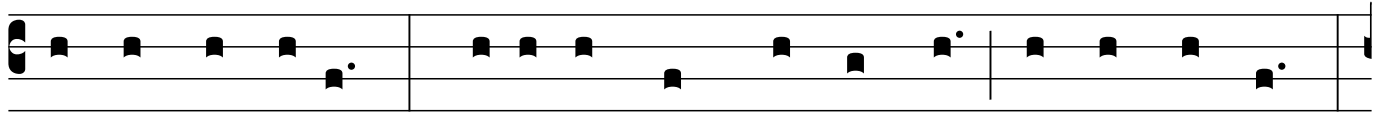
who were troubled with unclean spir-its were cured. And all in the crowd were

try- ing to touch him, for power came out from him and healed all of them.

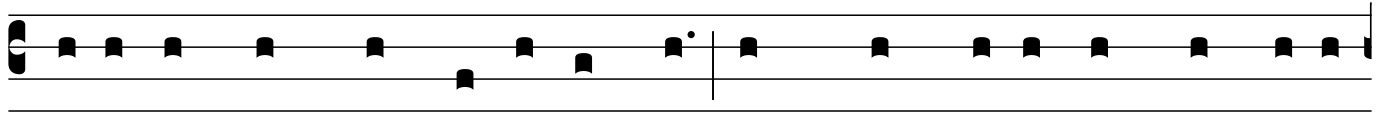
Then he looked up at his dis-ciples and said: ‘Blessed are you who are poor,



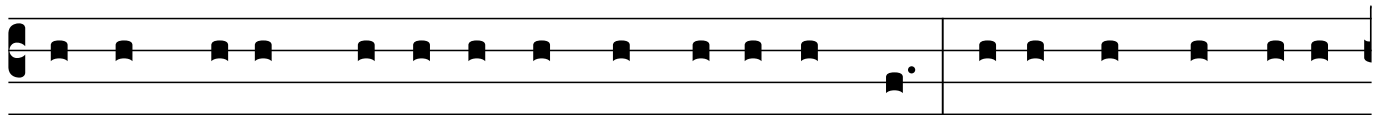
for yours is the kingdom of God. 'Blessed are you who are hungry now,



for you will be filled. 'Blessed are you who weep now, for you will laugh.



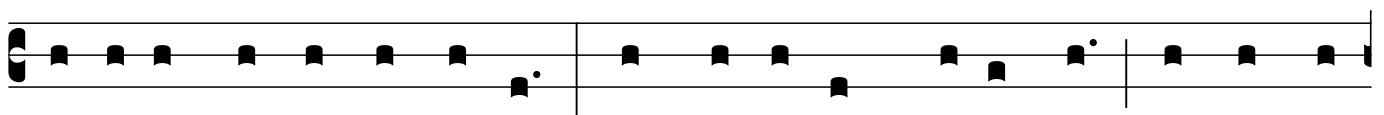
'Blessed are you when people hate you, and when they exclude you, re-vile



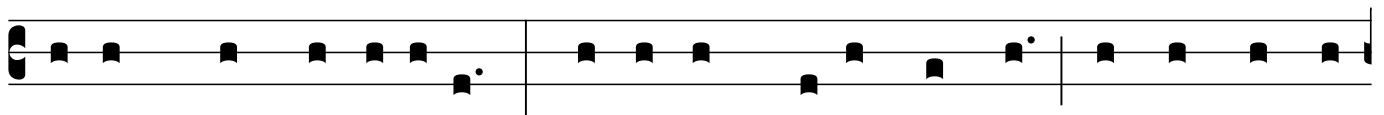
you, and de-fame you on account of the Son of Man. Re-joice on that day and



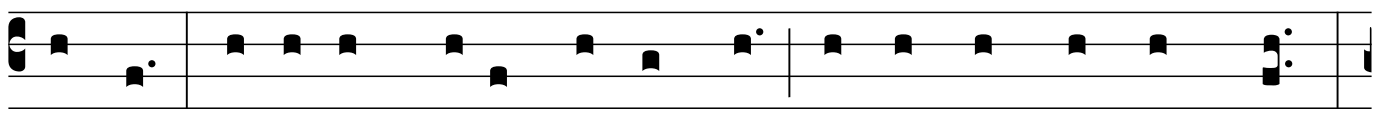
leap for joy, for surely your reward is great in heaven; for that is what their



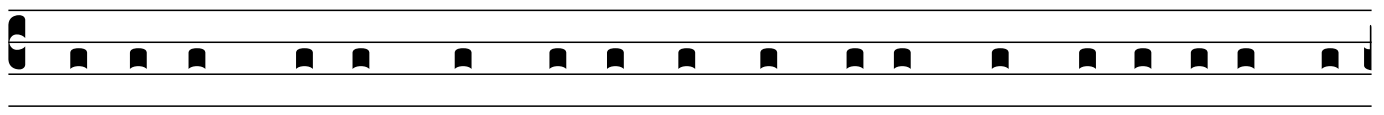
ancestors did to the prophets. 'But woe to you who are rich, for you have
