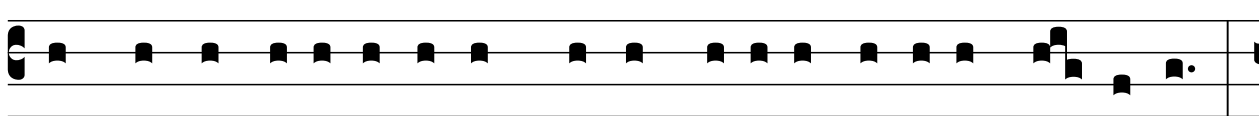
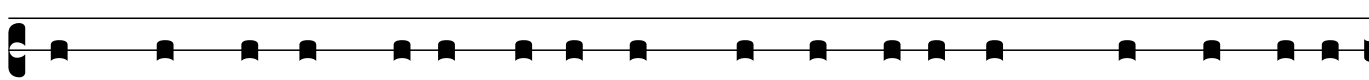

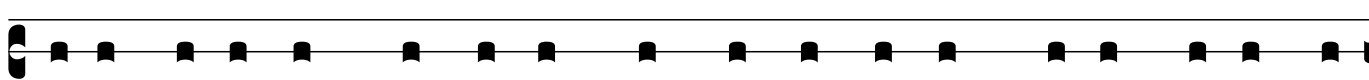

Live by the Spir-it, I say, and do not grat-i-fy the de-sires of the flesh.



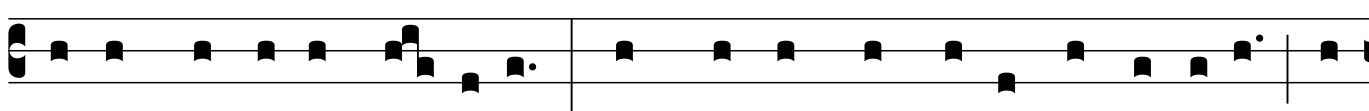
For what the flesh de-sires is opposed to the Spir-it, and what the Spir-it



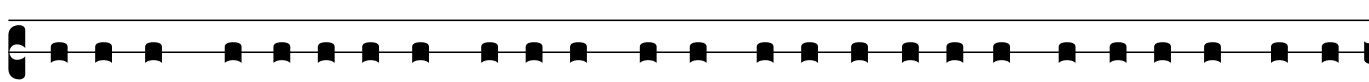

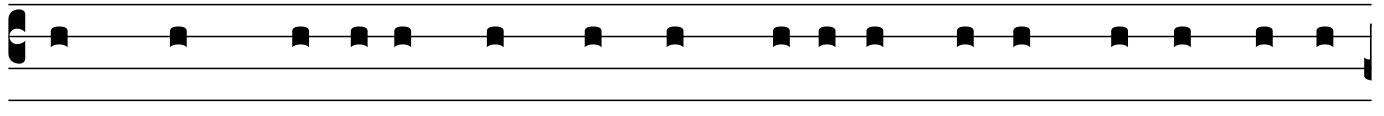
those who do such things will not inher-it the kingdom of God. By contrast,



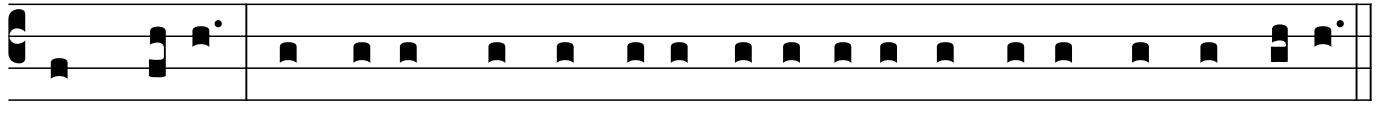
the fruit of the Spir-it is love, joy, peace, pa-tience, kindness, gen-er-os-i-ty,
