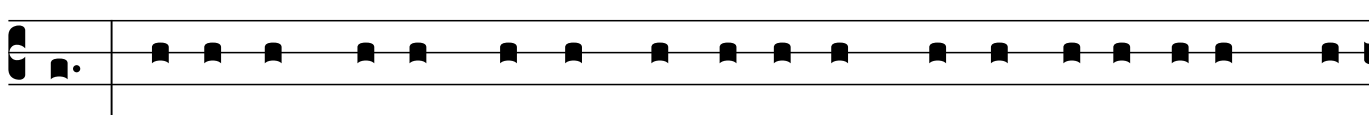

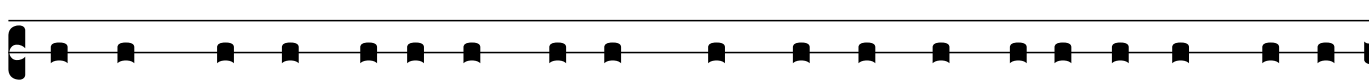

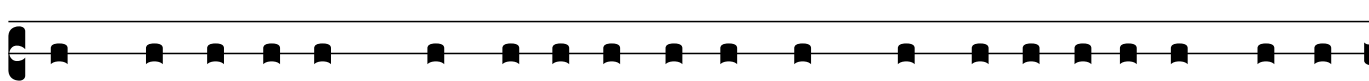
But each of us was giv-en grace according to the measure of Christ's



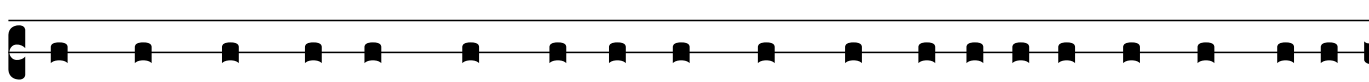
gift. He himself granted that some are a-postles, prophets, e-vange-lists, pas-



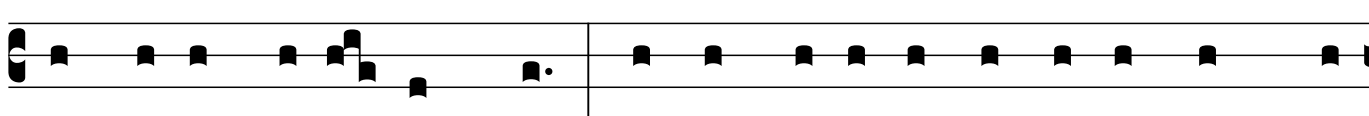
tors and teachers to equip the saints for the work of min-istry, for build-ing



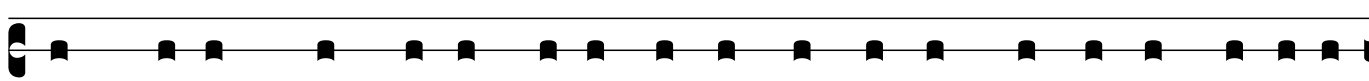
up the bod-y of Christ, until all of us come to the u-ni-ty of the faith



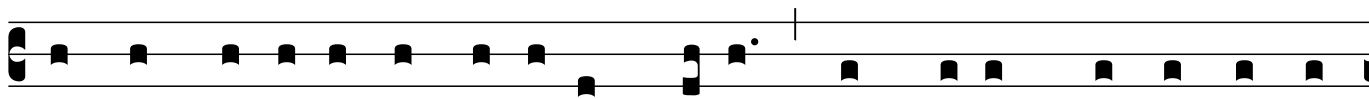
and of the knowledge of the Son of God, to ma-tur-i-ty, to the measure



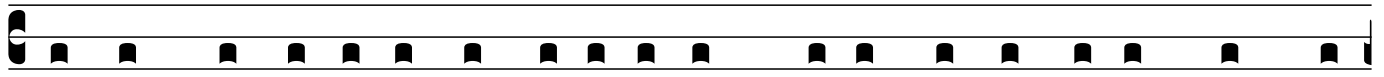
of the full stat-ure of Christ. We must no longer be children, tossed to

by their craft-i-ness in de-ceitful scheming; but speaking the truth in love,



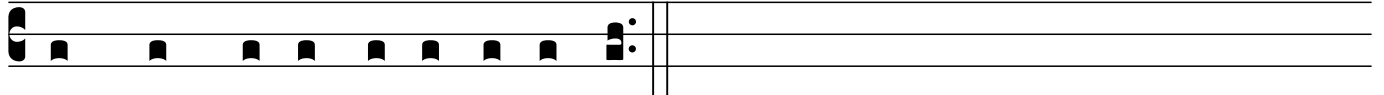
we must grow up in every way into him who is the head, into Christ, from
