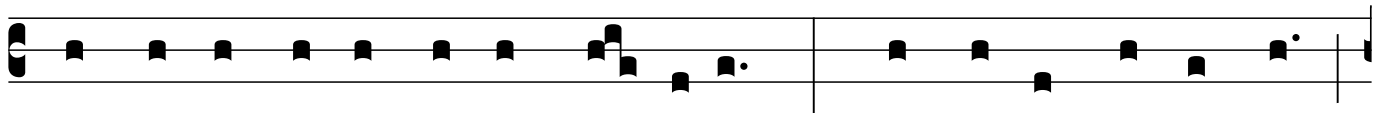
See what love the Father has giv-en us, that we should be called children



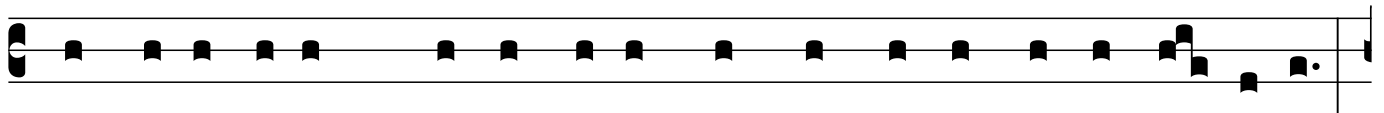

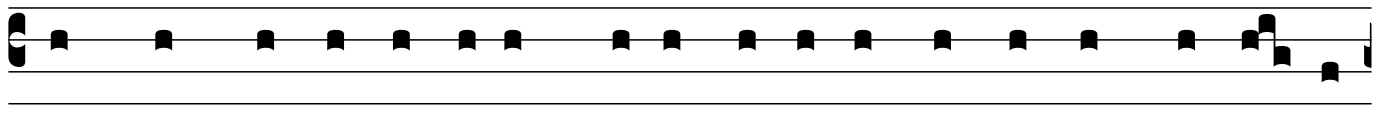
when he is revealed, we will be like him, for we will see him as he is.



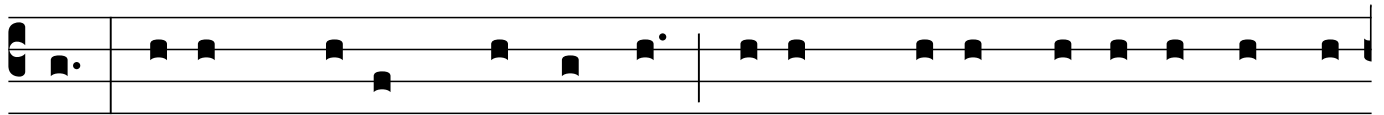
And all who have this hope in him pu-ri-fy themselves, just as he is pure.



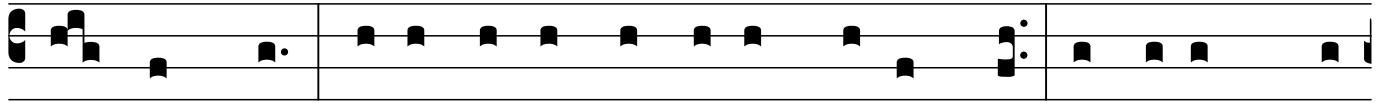
Every-one who commits sin is guilt-y of lawlessness; sin is lawlessness.



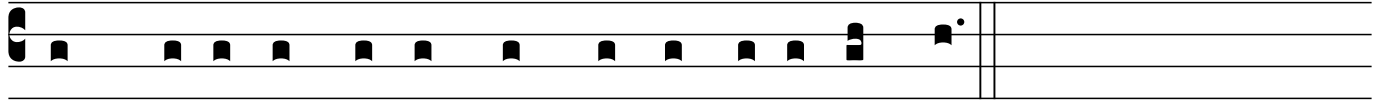
You know that he was revealed to take away sins, and in him there is no
