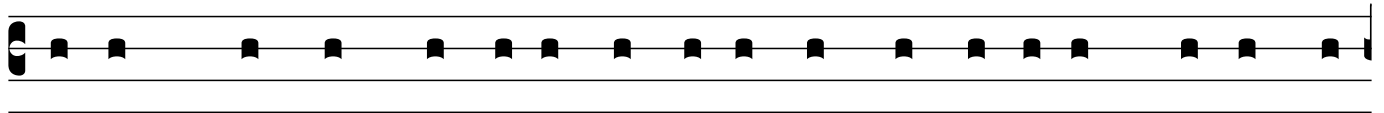
and shar-ers in the promise in Christ Je-sus through the gospel. Of this



gospel I have be-come a servant according to the gift of God's grace that was



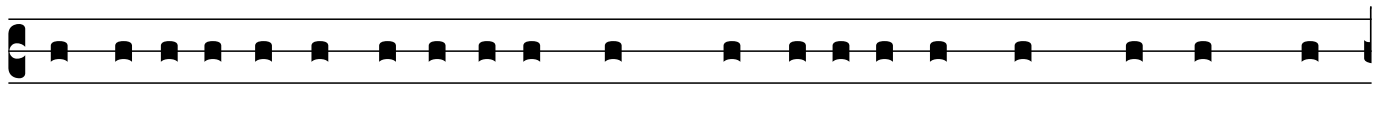
giv-en me by the working of his power. Although I am the ver-y least of all



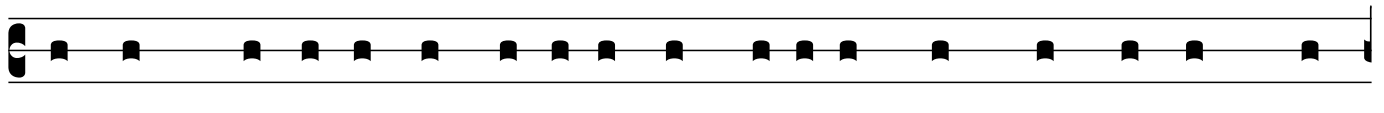
the saints, this grace was giv-en to me to bring to the gentiles the news of



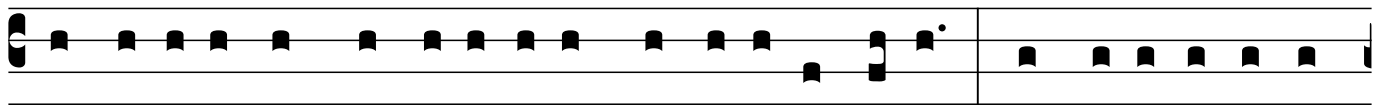
the boundless riches of Christ and to make every-one see what is the plan of



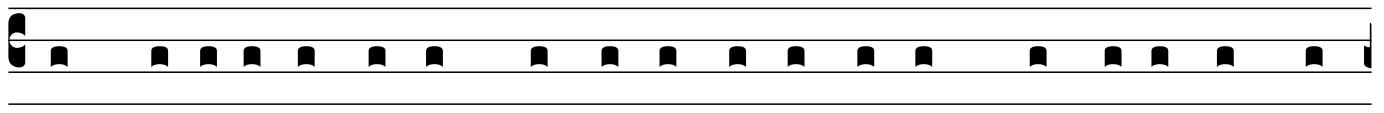
the myster-y hidden for ag-es in God, who cre- at-ed all things, so that through



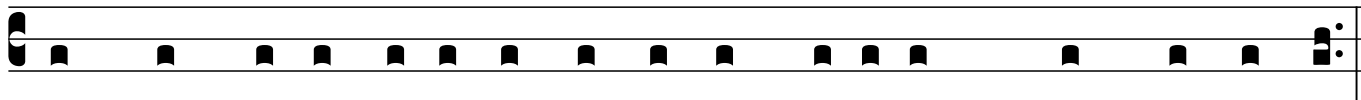
the church the wisdom of God in its rich va-ri- ety might now be made known
