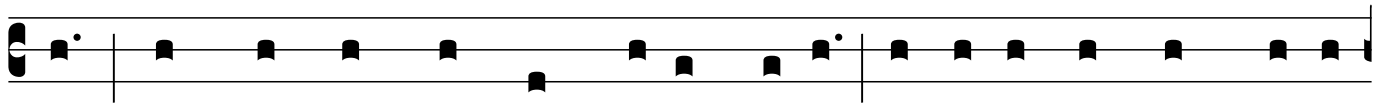
sound of man-y wa-ters and like the sound of mighty thunderpeals, cry- ing



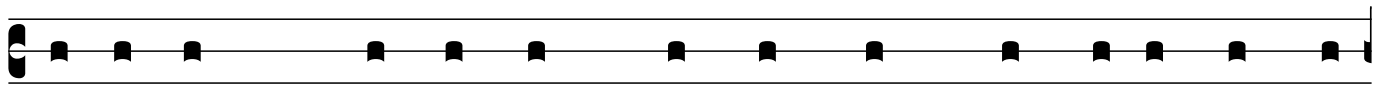
out, “Hal-lelujah! For the Lord God the Almight-y reigns. Let us re-joice



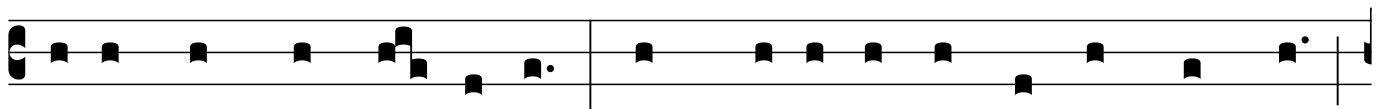
and ex-ult and give him the glo-ry, for the marriage of the Lamb has



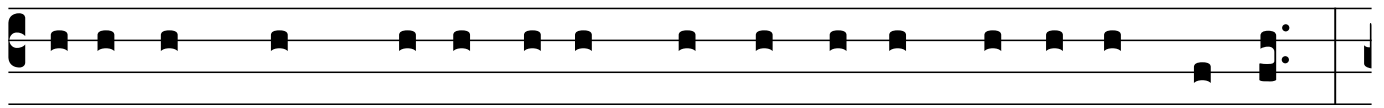
come, and his bride has made herself ready; to her it has been granted



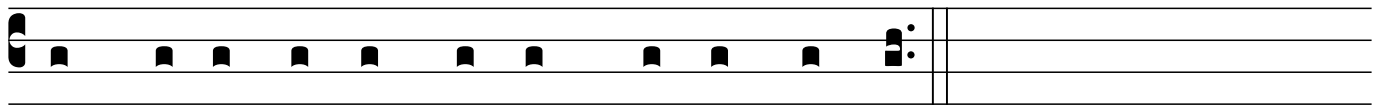
to be clothed with fine linen, bright and pure”—for the fine linen is
