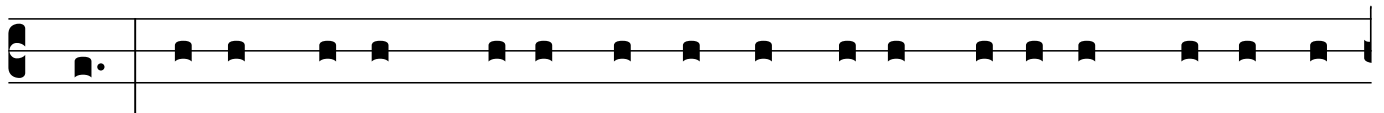
and the same Spir-it, who al-lots to each one indi-vid-u-al-ly just as the



Spir-it chooses. For just as the bod-y is one and has man-y members, and



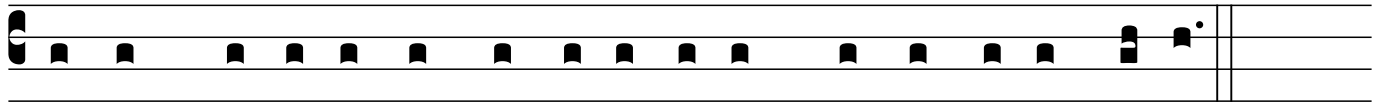
all the members of the bod-y, though man-y, are one bod-y, so it is with
