


# 1 Corinthians 12:3b-13

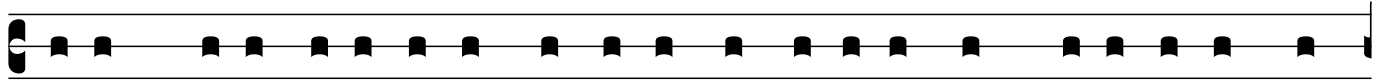
*Pentecost (Principal)*



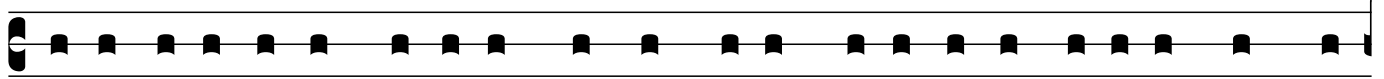

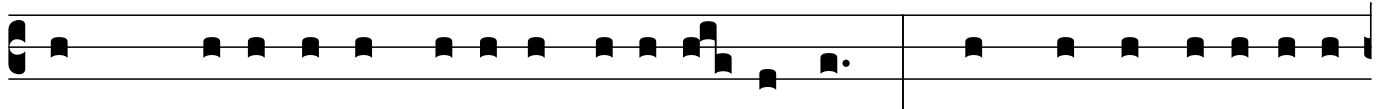
Spir-it, to an-other faith by the same Spir-it, to an-other gifts of heal-ing by



the one Spir-it, to an-other the working of powerful deeds, to an-other proph-



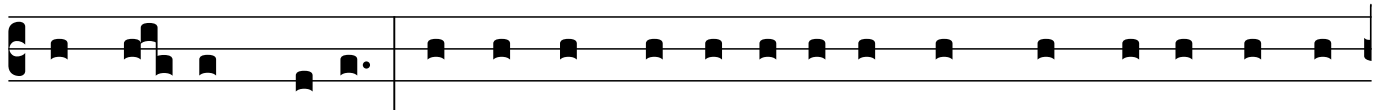
e-cy, to an-other the discernment of spir-its, to an-other var-i-ous kinds of



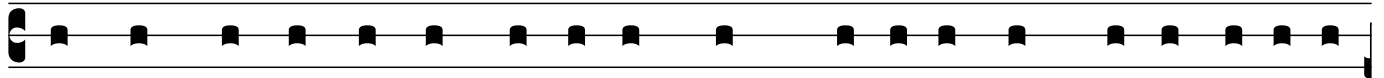
tongues, to an-other the interpre-tation of tongues. All these are acti-vat-ed



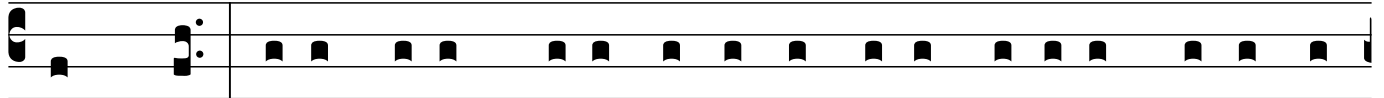
by one and the same Spir-it, who al-lots to each one indi-vid-u- al-ly just as



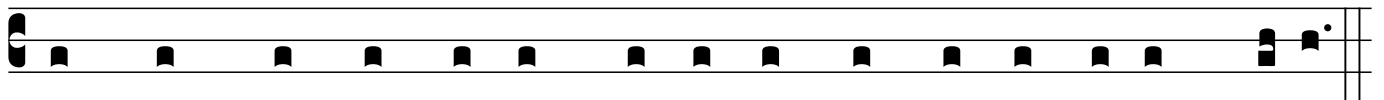
the Spir- it chooses. For just as the bod-y is one and has man-y members,
