
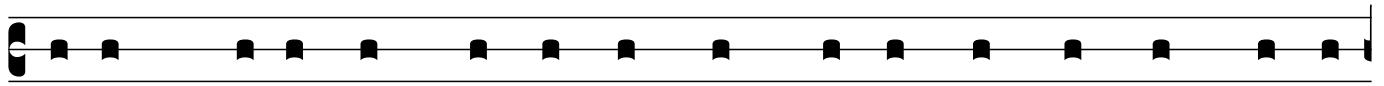


# James 5:13-20

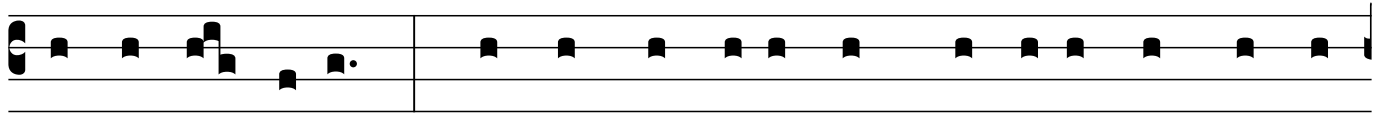

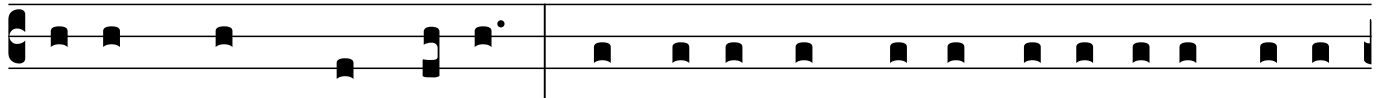
**A**re an-y among you suffer-ing? They should pray. Are an-y cheer-

is powerful and ef-fective. E-li- jah was a human like us, and he prayed



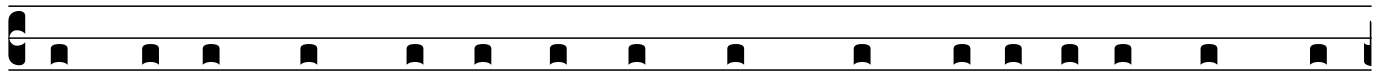
fervently that it might not rain, and for three years and six months it did



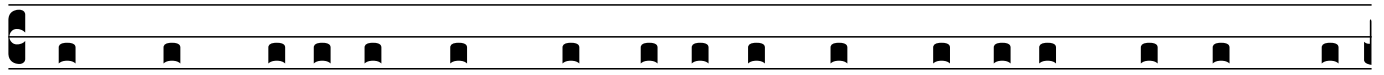
not rain on the earth. Then he prayed again, and the heaven gave rain, and



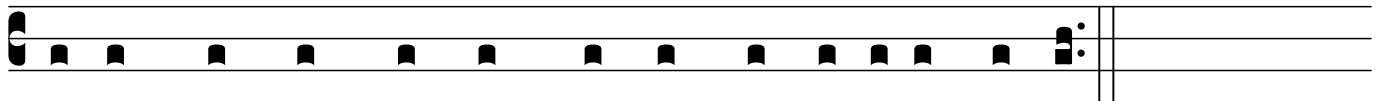
the earth yielded its harvest. My brothers and sis-ters, if an-y- one among
