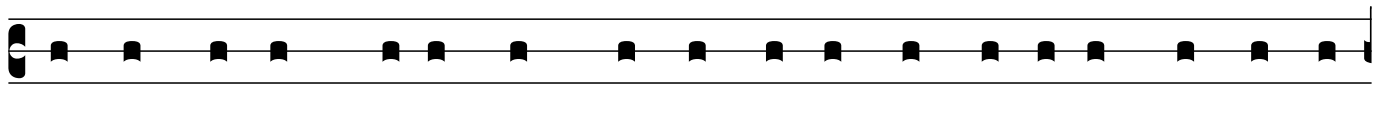
convince, re-buke, and encourage with the utmost pa-tience in teaching.



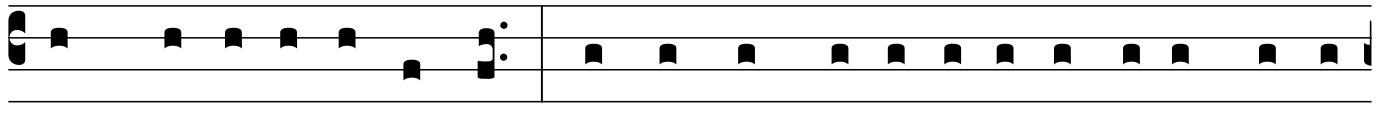
For the time is coming when people will not put up with sound teaching,



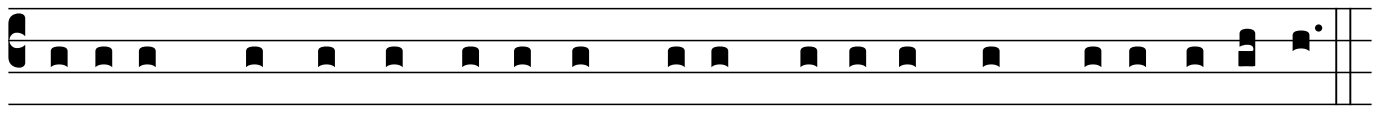
but, hav-ing their ears tickled, they will accumu-late for themselves teachers
