


# Romans 6:1b-11

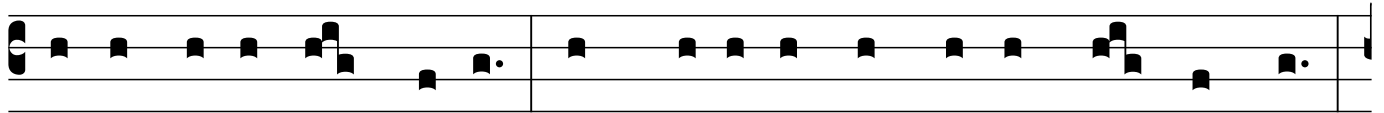

**W**hat then are we to say? Should we continue in sin in order that  
grace may increase? By no means! How can we who died to sin go on liv-ing  
in it? Do you not know that all of us who were baptized into Christ Je-sus  
were baptized into his death? Therefore we were buried with him by baptism  
into death, so that, just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glo-ry  
of the Father, so we also might walk in newness of life. For if we have  
been u-nit-ed with him in a death like his, we will certainly be u-nit-ed with  
him in a res-urrection like his. We know that our old self was cru-ci-fied



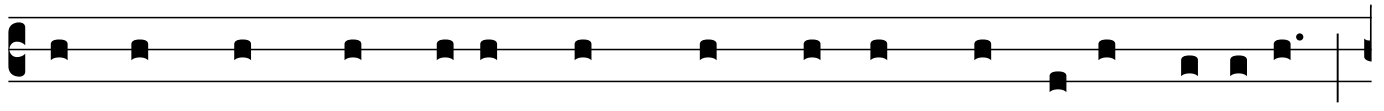
with him so that the bod-y of sin might be destroyed, so we might no



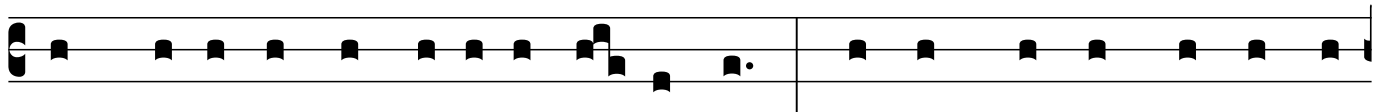
longer be enslaved to sin. For who- ev-er has died is freed from sin.



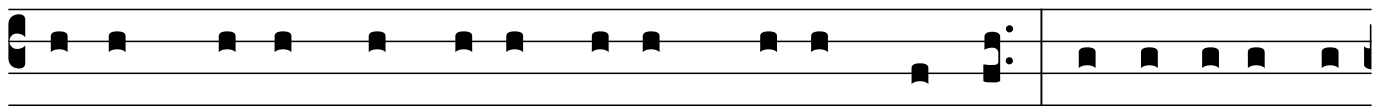
But if we died with Christ, we be-lieve that we will also live with him.



We know that Christ, be- ing raised from the dead, will nev-er die again;



death no longer has dominion o- ver him. The death he died, he died to



sin once for all, but the life he lives, he lives to God. So you also must



consid-er yourselves dead to sin and a-live to God in Christ Je-sus.
