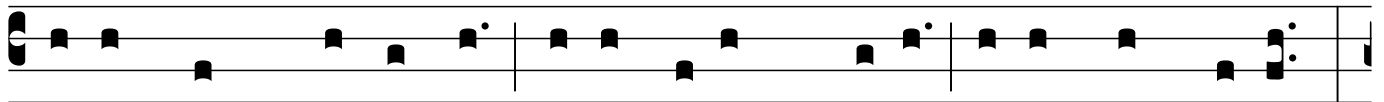
you, be so-ber in every-thing, en-dure suffer-ing, do the work of an e-van-



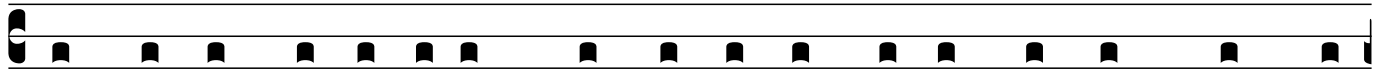
ge-list, carry out your min-is-try ful-ly. As for me, I am already be-



ing poured out as a li-bation, and the time of my de-parture has come.



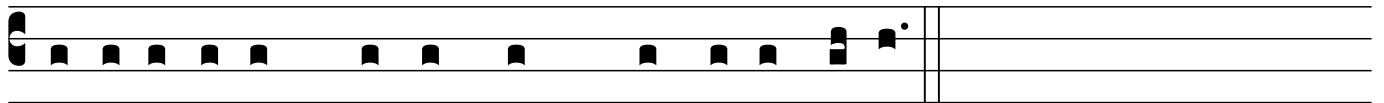
I have fought the good fight; I have fin-ished the race; I have kept the faith.
