
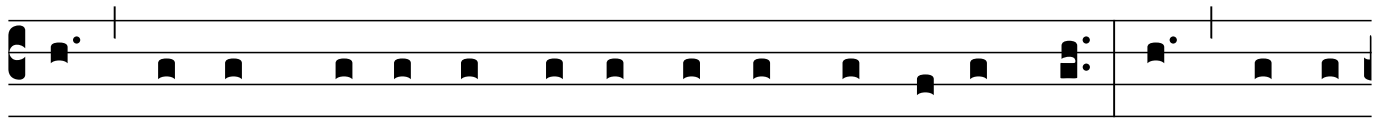


# Romans 10:8b-18

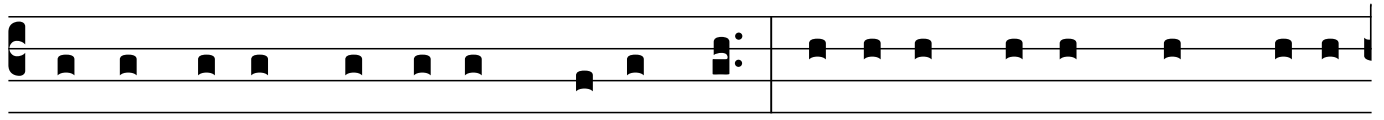

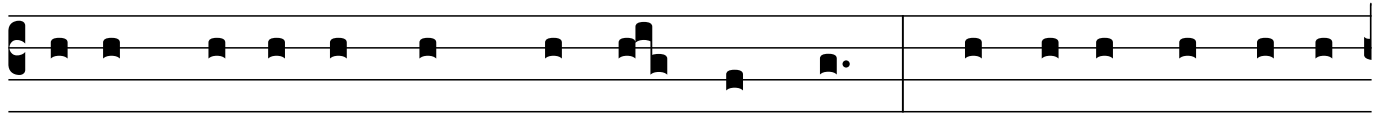

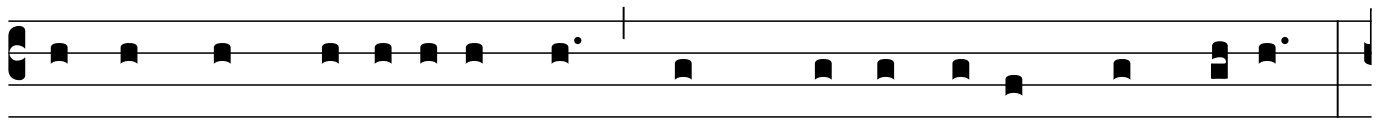
And how are they to hear without someone to proclaim him? And how are



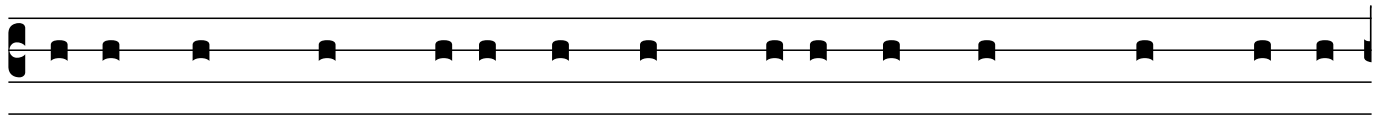
they to proclaim him unless they are sent? As it is writ-ten, “How beauti-



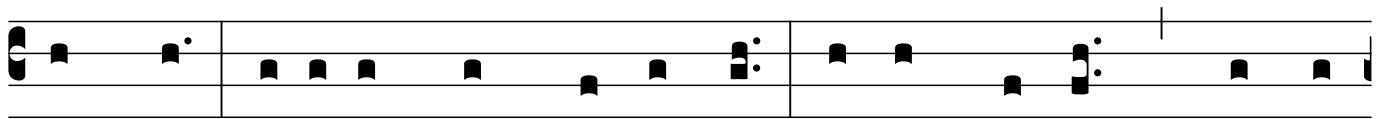
ful are the feet of those who bring good news!” But not all have obeyed



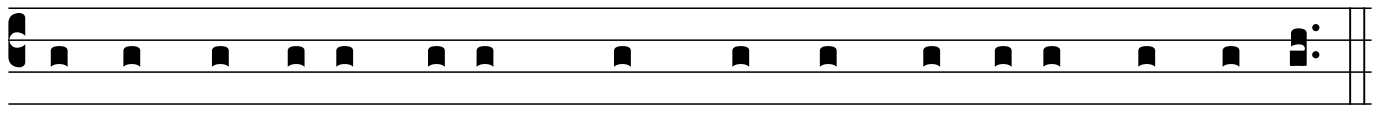
the good news, for I-sa-iah says, “Lord, who has be-lieved our message?”
