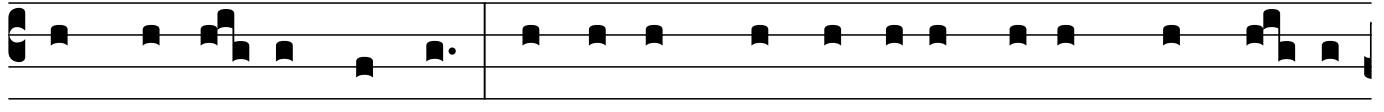
I think it right, as long as I am in this bod-y, to refresh your mem-

the Father when that voice was conveyed to him by the Ma-jes-tic Glo-ry,



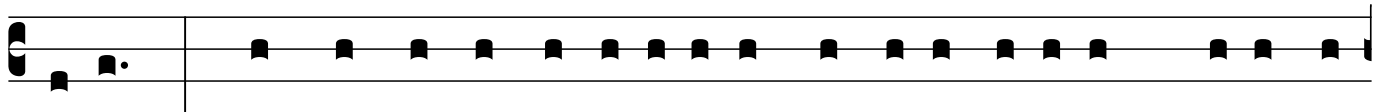
say-ing, "This is my Son, my Be-lov-ed, with whom I am well pleased."



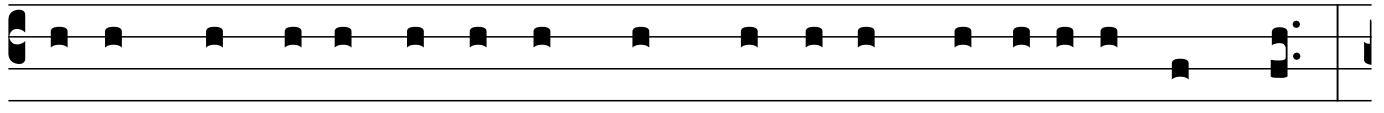
We ourselves heard this voice come from heaven, while we were with him



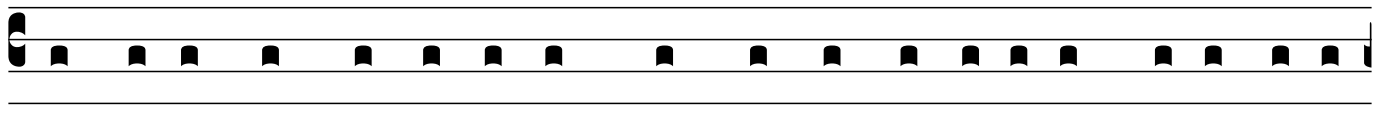
on the ho- ly mountain. So we have the prophet-ic message more ful- ly



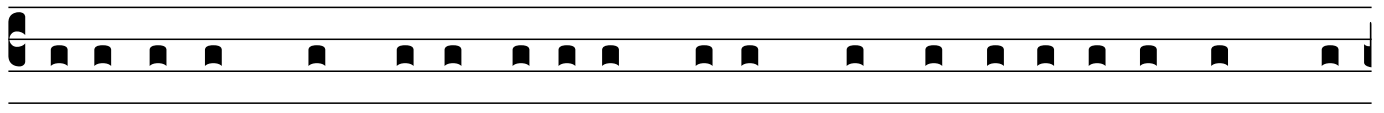
confirmed. You will do well to be attentive to this as to a lamp shin-ing in



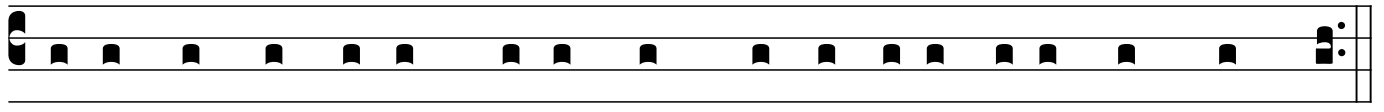
a dark place, until the day dawns and the morning star ris-es in your hearts.
