
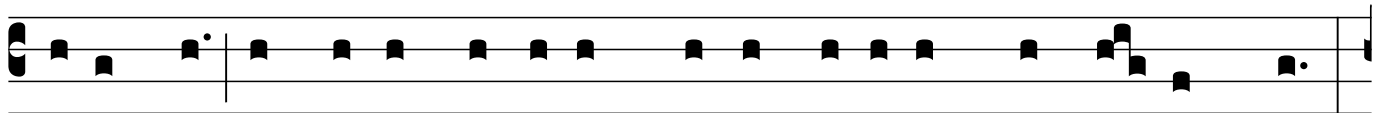


# Acts 3:1-10

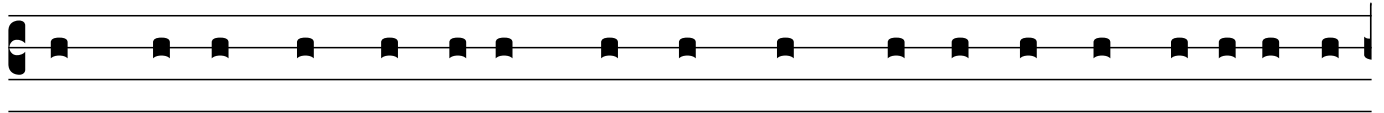
Wednesday in Easter Week



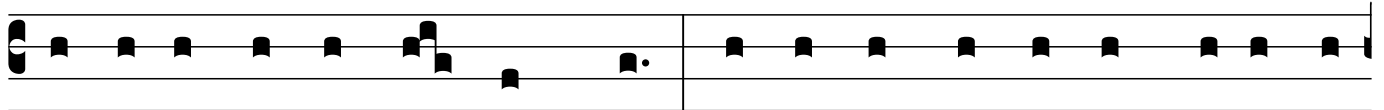

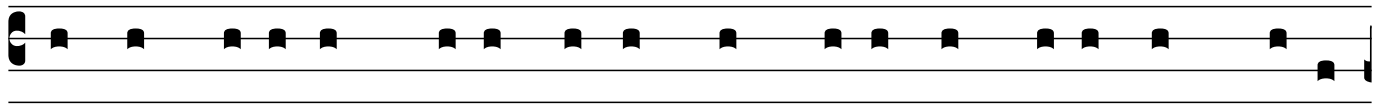
I give you; in the name of Je-sus Christ of Naz-a-reth, stand up and walk.”



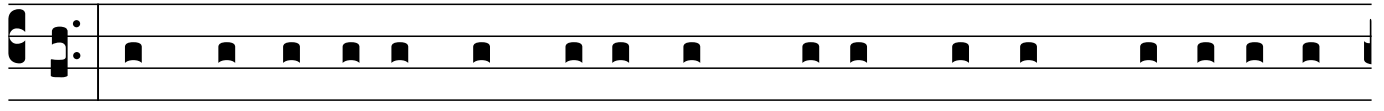
And he took him by the right hand and raised him up, and imme-di- ately



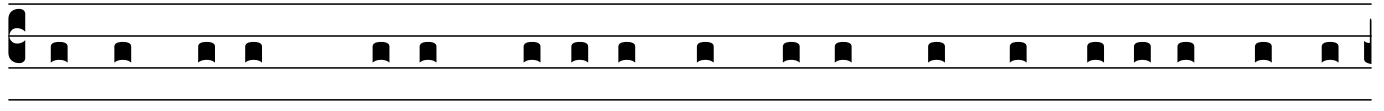
his feet and ankles were made strong. Jumping up, he stood and be-gan to



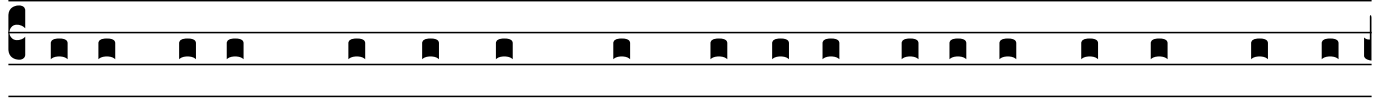
walk, and he entered the temple with them, walking and leaping and prais-ing



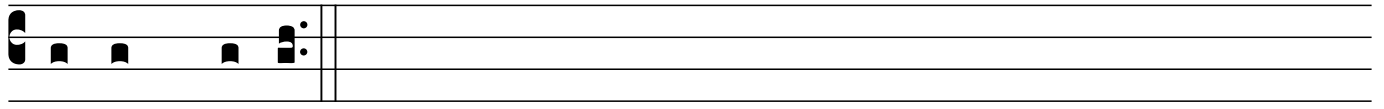
God. All the people saw him walking and prais-ing God, and they rec-ognized
